

# FCC Adopts Universal Service and Intercarrier Compensation Reform

Today, the FCC adopted its much-anticipated [Universal Service/Intercarrier Compensation Reform Order](#). This order will have significant impacts for all telecommunications carriers, and also for interconnected VoIP providers. The full order, which is approximately 600 pages long, has not been released yet.
