

Law360 Mentions Kelley Drye's Representation in a \$2.8 Billion U.S. Department of Education Debt Deal

Partners [William MacLeod](#), and [David Frulla](#) and senior associate [Elizabeth Johnson](#) were mentioned in the *Law360* article "\$2.8B Ed. Dept. Debt Deal Cases Stayed For Solution Talks."

The \$2.8 billion U.S. Department of Education contract covers the collection of unpaid student loan debts issued by federal loan programs. Only seven out of 23 companies were awarded the contract, causing a number of bid protests. Judge Susan G. Braden granted a 30-day stay for the parties involved to come up with a "global solution" to the arguments. Until May 19, all protestors agreed to temporarily stop the disputes.
