

Law360 Mentions Partner Jonathan K. Cooperman as Counsel to Buchanan Ingersoll in Overthrown Malpractice Lawsuit

Partner [Jonathan K. Cooperman](#) achieved the dismissal of malpractice claims against law firm Buchanan Ingersoll & Rooney PC brought by investor Abraham Lesser who was held liable for \$52.9 million after loans for Seattle and Philadelphia-based real estate projects defaulted. The *Law360* article “Buchanan Ducks Malpractice Claims In \$53M Loan Default Row” discusses the plaintiff’s claims that Buchanan Ingersoll failed to properly advise him on signing documents guaranteeing loans for doomed projects in Philadelphia and Seattle. The New York Supreme Court Justice Carolyn E. Demarest ruled the absence of an attorney-client relationship negated the malpractice claims.
