

Plastic News Quotes Partner Paul C. Rosenthal on PET Duties

Partner [Paul C. Rosenthal](#) was quoted in the *Plastic News* article “U.S. to levy duties on PET resin from Canada, China, India and Oman.” The U.S. International Trade Commission on March 31 voted 6-0 that PET imports from Canada, China, India and Oman are causing injury to the U.S. PET industry. As a result, anti-dumping duties now will be placed on PET imported from those nations. An anti-dumping complaint had been filed in March 2015 by PET makers DAK Americas LLC, M&G Group and Nan Ya Plastics Corp. The three companies are represented by Kelley Drye. Mr. Rosenthal said that the domestic PET industry “is extremely pleased that the commission agreed, and that these importers now will be subject to the discipline of trade orders to offset these practices.”
