



The American Lawyer Spotlights Kelley Drye's Pro Bono Legal Relief Initiative

One year after the 9/11 terrorist attacks, The American Lawyer's September issue reflects on the increased interest in pro bono work nationwide, citing Kelley Drye as a prime example.
