The Climate Change train is speeding along parallel tracks. On the legislative track, the House already has passed a comprehensive Climate/Energy bill (the American Clean Energy and Security Act - aka "Waxman-Markey"), and an evolving climate bill is now moving through Committees of jurisdiction in the Senate. On the regulatory track, EPA is moving aggressively to regulate Green House Gas (GHG) emissions from mobile and stationary sources under existing Clean Air Act authority.
