Maintenance

Aluminium & Steel

These will be chrome plated, bright polished or powder coated depending on the components & finishes of your chair. These parts can be cleaned with a damp cloth & in the case of polished or chrome parts, buffed dry with a soft non-abrasive cloth to prevent streak marks. For chrome plated finishes, stubborn stains can be removed using a metal cleaner. Do not use abrasive cleaning agents in case of damage.

Wood

Dust regularly. Clean hard surfaces with a damp cloth & then polish with a soft dry cloth, microfibre cloths are ideal for both purposes. Polish in the direction of the grain. **DO NOT** use spray polishes/cleaners or waxes which may damage the finish & result in an undesirable sheen & a sticky build-up which can be difficult to remove.

For heavier general soiling & marks on hard surfaces soak a cloth in a mild solution of soapy water, wring until damp, not dripping wet, & wipe the surface concerned. Then wipe with a clean, not soapy, damp cloth & finish by drying with a soft cloth.

To remove tape/sticker residue, grease, chewing gum, make-up & adhesives, try 'De-solv-it Sticky Stuff Remover', available on line & in some hardware stores. Other stubborn marks can sometimes be removed with Isopropyl Alcohol, available from Chemist. Use both these sparingly & with care.

Mesh

Vacuum regularly & occasionally wipe clean with a damp cloth.

Plastic

Wipe with a damp cloth periodically. Dust can gather in some hard to reach areas, particularly between the seat & back of a task chair. Stubborn stains (pen etc) may require a mild household cleaning agent to remove – particularly on light coloured plastic components. Do not use any abrasive cleaning products on plastic parts as these may damage the surface.



Maintenance

Nylon Parts

Wipe with a damp cloth periodically.

Leather & Fabric Upholstery

Refer to manufacturers cleaning guidelines for individual fabric details. In general most fabrics can be vacuumed regularly & wiped clean with a damp cloth or shampoo using a proprietary upholstery shampoo.

Minimise the risk of damage

- Avoid over exposure to direct sunlight.
- Avoid exposure to excessive heat from a fire, radiator or local high temperature light sources.

General - Following these simple maintenance procedures will enable trouble free use. Should any components appear to be loose the cause should be investigated without delay & the appropriate fixing tightened where possible. If this does not provide a solution please contact Alchemy Furniture.
