A GREAT PROMISE FULFILLED

You are witnesses of these things. 49 I am going to send you what my Father has promised; but stay in the city until you have been clothed with power from on high."

- Luke 24:48-49

- ⁸ LAUNCHES KEY JOURNEYS By faith Abraham, when called to go to a place he would later receive as his inheritance, obeyed and went, even though he did not know where he was going.
- "ENABLES SUPERNATURAL PROMISES FULFILLMENT And by faith even Sarah, who was past childbearing age, was enabled to bear children because she[b] considered him faithful who had made the promise.

Tonsequently, faith comes from hearing the message, and the message is heard through the word ($\dot{p}\ddot{\eta}\mu\alpha$ - spoken word) about Christ.
