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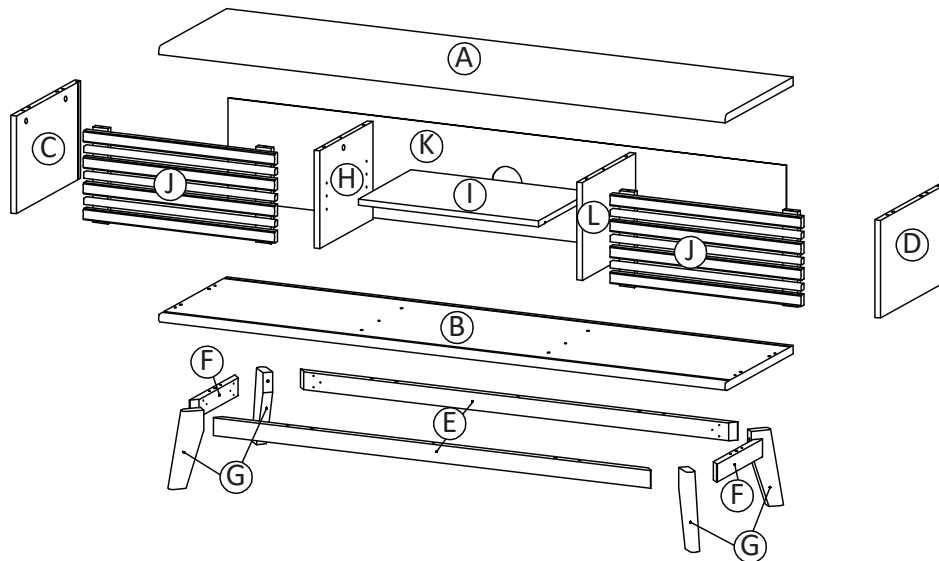

## CARE AND MAINTENANCE

Always use felt pads under all articles to prevent discoloration or softening of the lacquer. Plastic and rubber bases on items can discolor wood. Wipe up spills immediately and avoid common hazards such as hot dishes, harsh solvents and abrasives. Cleaning should be done with a soft lint free cotton cloth dampened with water or furniture polish. On highly used surfaces we recommend applying a quality paste wax which should be used on a regular basis to provide additional protection from scratches and spills. How often you apply the wax depends on how much wear the furniture receives.

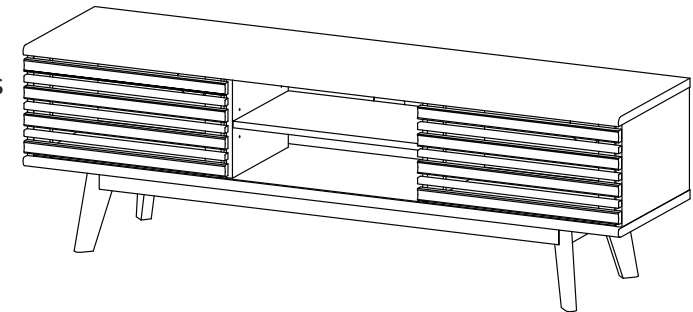

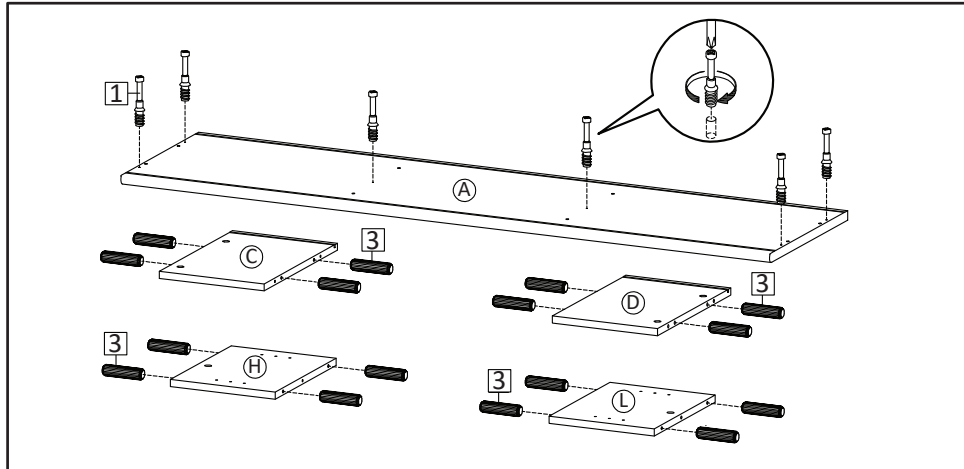
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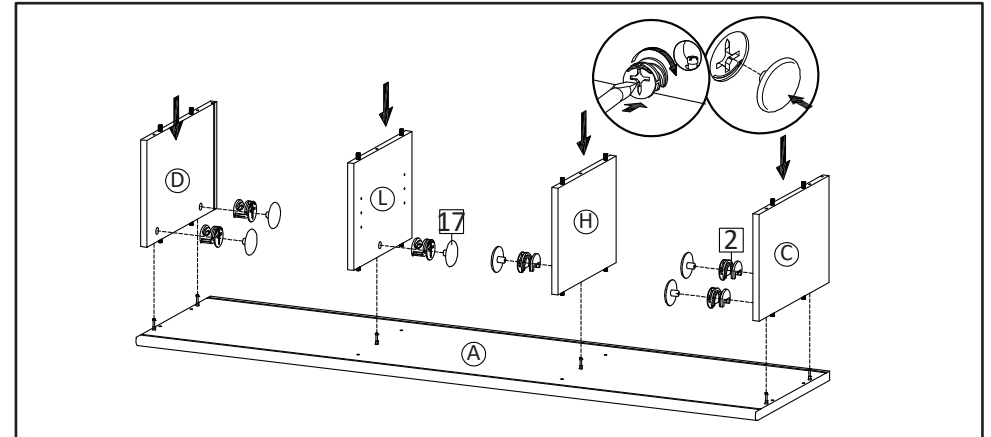
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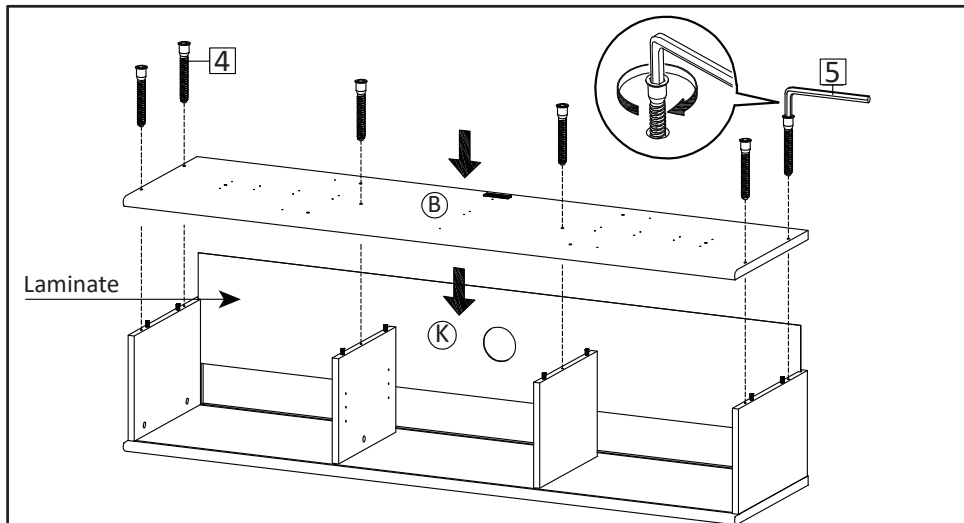
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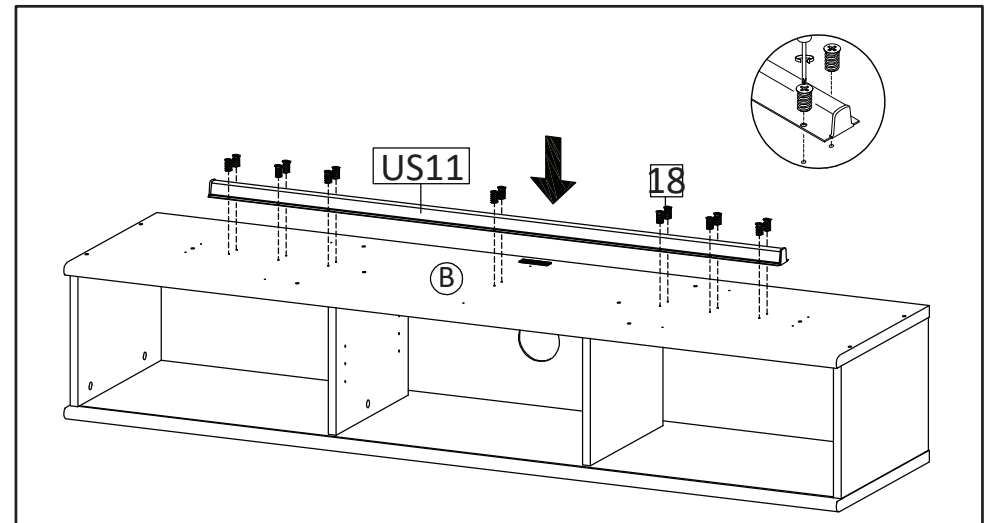
**STEP1:** Insert Cambolt (HW1) into Top Board (A)  
Insert Dowel (HW3) into Center Boards (H & L),  
Side Board Left (C) and Side Board Right (D).



**STEP2:** Attach Side Board Left (C), Side Board Right (D),  
Center Boards (H & L) to Top Board (A).  
Insert Camlock (HW2) then tighten using screwdriver.  
Put Screw Cover (HW17) over the camlock.



**Step3:** Insert Backboard (K) as shown in the figure above.  
Place bottom board on top and secure with Screw M7x50 (HW4),  
tighten screws using Allen Key (HW5).



**STEP4:** Place Anti Deflection Metal Bar (HW US11),  
secure with screw M 6 x12,5 (HW18) using screwdriver.

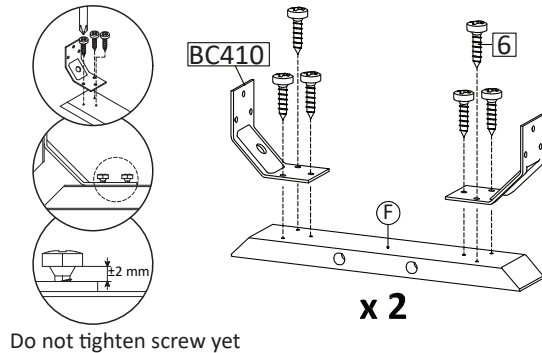
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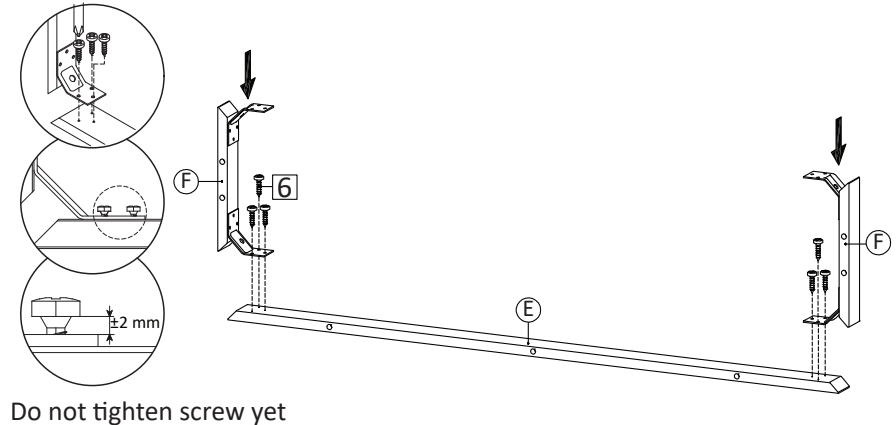
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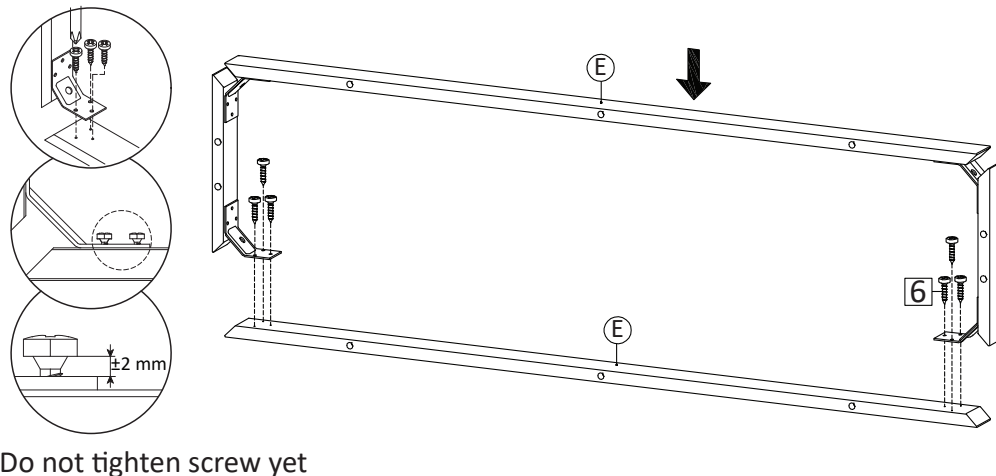
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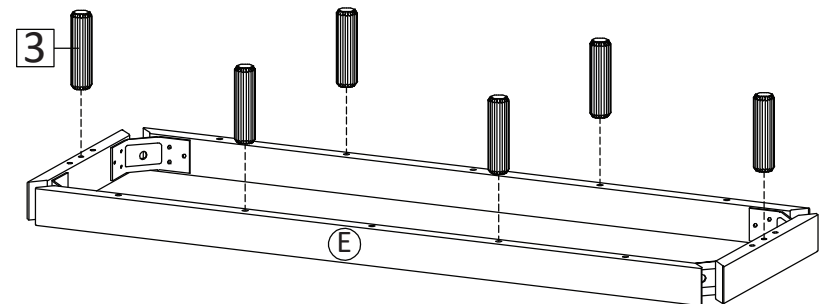
**STEP5:** Now lets assemble the Support Leg. Start with installing Corner Brace (HW BC410) into Support Leg 2 (F) using Screw M4x16 (HW6). Do not overtighten the screws yet, leave around 2mm gap.



**STEP6:** Combine the Support Leg 2 from step 5 with Support Leg 1 (E), using Screw M4x16 (HW6). Do not overtighten the screws yet, leave around 2mm gap.



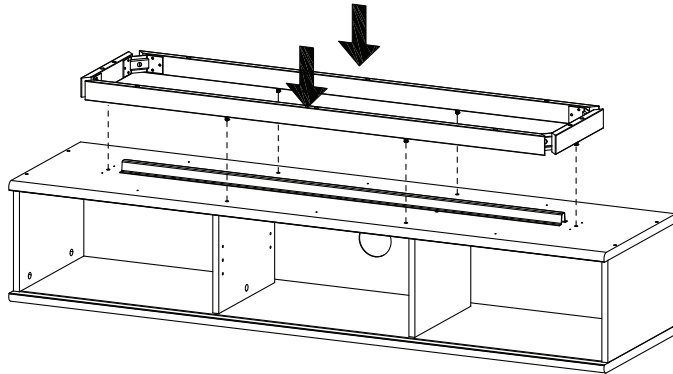
**STEP7:** Combine components from step 6 with remaining Support Leg 1 (E), using Screw M4x16 (HW6). Do not overtighten the screws yet, leave around 2mm gap.



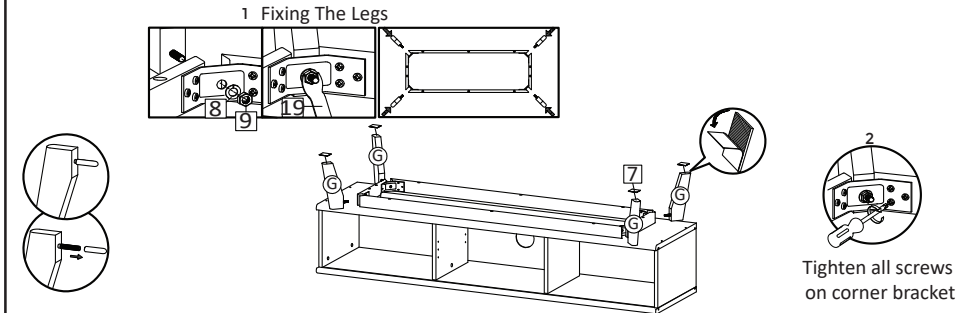
**STEP8:** Insert Dowel (HW3) into assembled Support Leg.

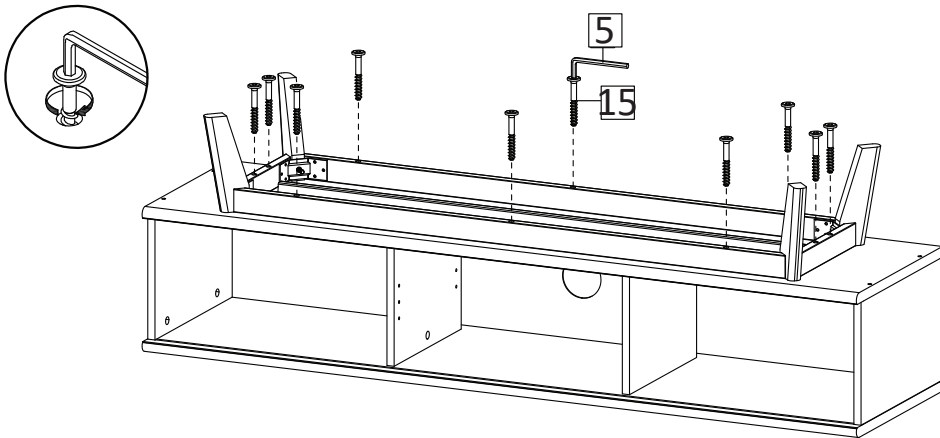
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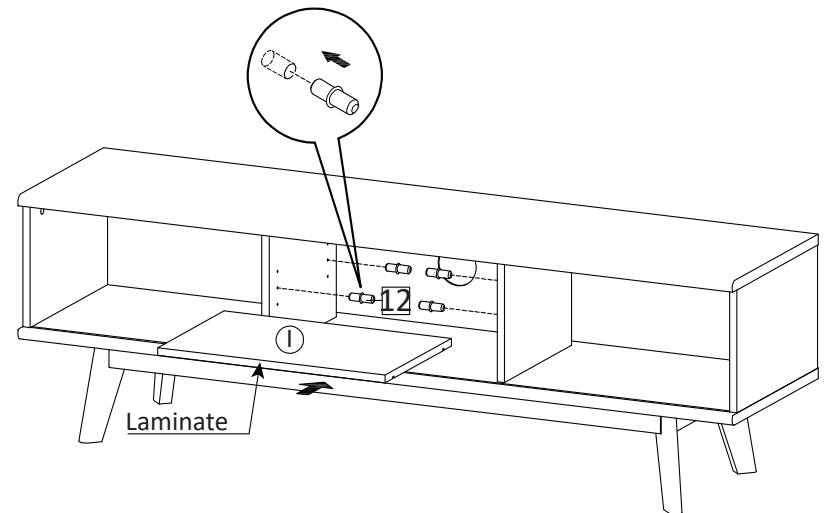
**STEP9:** Attach the assembled Support Legs to Bottom Board (B).



**STEP10:** Remove plastic cap from Legs. Insert the bolt of the Leg (G) into hole of corner brace as shown in the figure above. Insert Spring Washer (HW8) first into the hanger bolt of leg, then followed by Nut (HW9), tighten all the nuts using provided Wrench (HW19). Ensure that all legs have been tightened then tighten all screws on the corner brace.



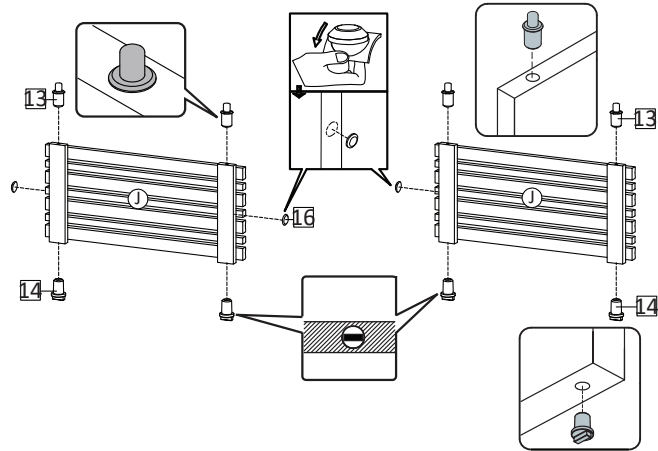
**STEP11:** Insert Screw M6.4 x 53 (HW15) and tighten using Allen Key (HW5).



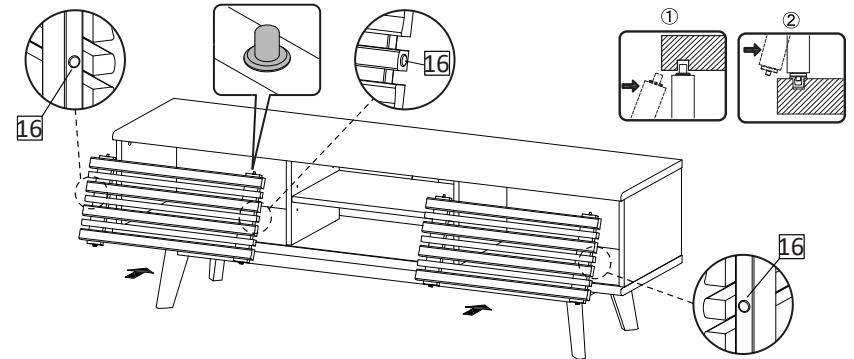
**STEP12:** After bringing the product upright, insert Shelf Pins (HW12) in between the Centerboards on the desired level. Then place the Adjustable Shelf (I) onto the Shelf Pin.

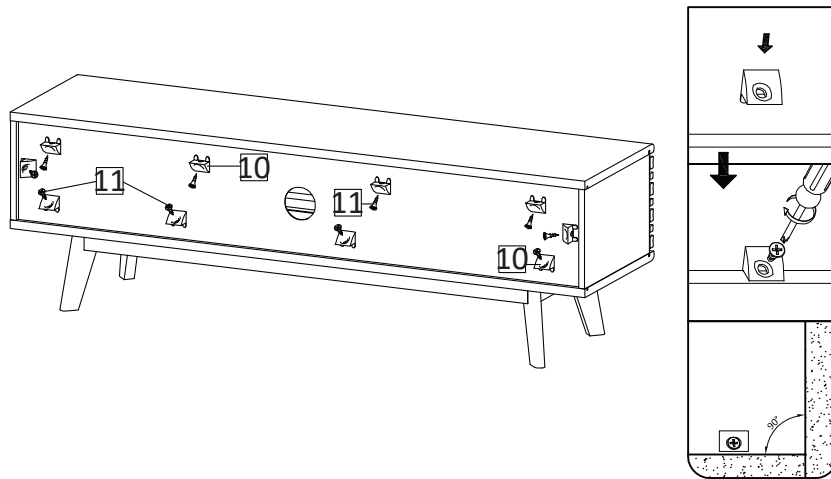
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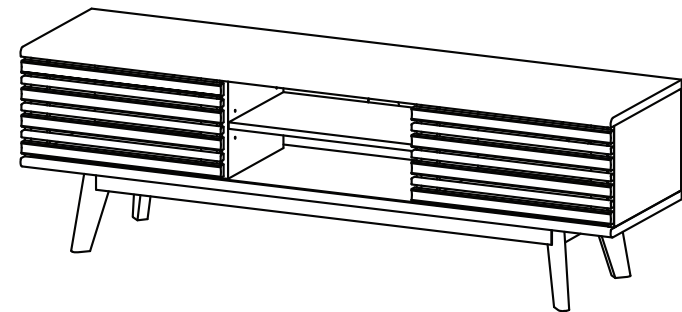
**STEP13:** Peel the back paper of Bumper ( HW16) then place on both frame door,position as shown in the figure. Insert Top Pin Sliding (HW13) and Bottom Pin Sliding (HW14) on both end of frame door as specified position in the figure.



**STEP14:** Hold the frame door with position of the upper pin shown in facing upward. Put the frame door by inserting it to the upper groove on Top Board (1), then place the lower part aligned into the groove on bottom board (2). Repeat this step for the other door. Slide the item's doors left and right to ensure the doors have been placed properly.



**STEP15:** Using Wedge (HW10) and Screw M 3.5 x15.5 (HW11) tighten the back of media stand with screwdriver.



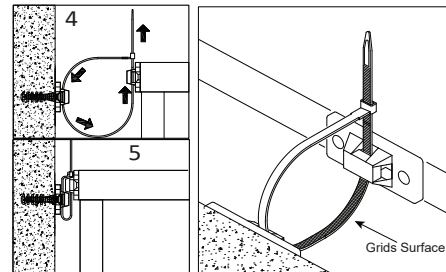
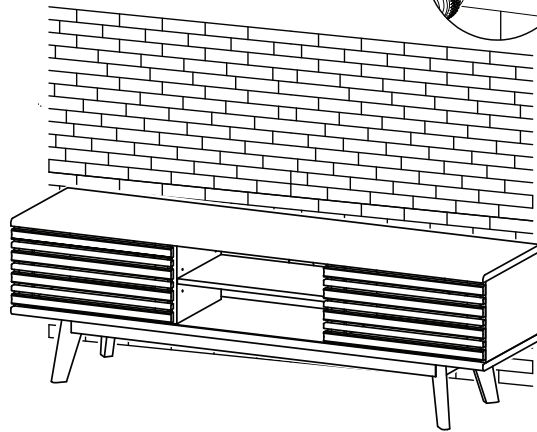
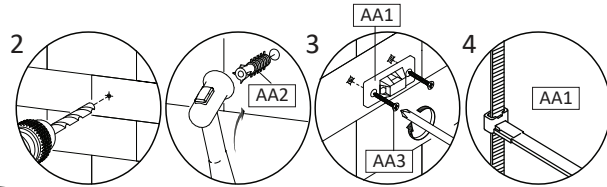
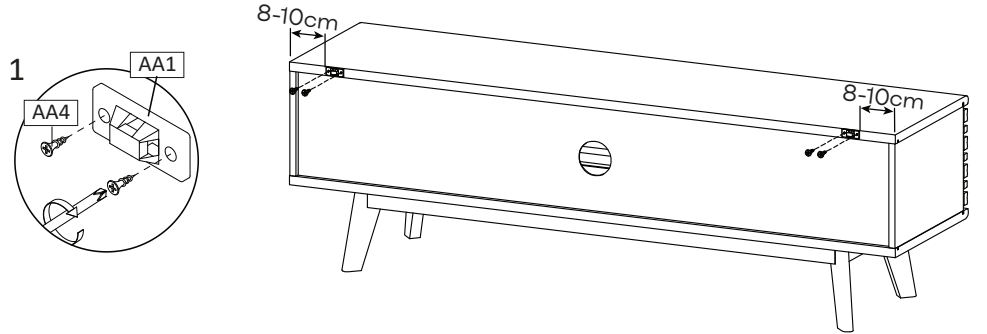
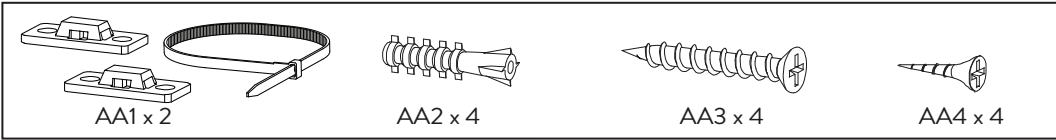
**STEP16:** Assembly is completed.

# TIPPING RESTRAINTS KIT INSTALLATION GUIDANCE

Different wall materials require unique wall fasteners.

The wall plugs (AA2) and screws (AA3) are designed for fixing to concrete walls only.

Please consult your local hardware store to ensure you are using the correct hardware for your wall type.



## Installation Instructions :

1. Attach bracket (AA1) securely to the back top of the furniture using screw (AA4) provided. Allow 8 - 10 cm from each side.
2. Please make a hole for wall plugs position on the wall and minimum 15 mm below bracket secured to the back of unit attach the wall plugs (AA2).
3. Locate the other bracket (AA1) on the wall over wall plugs (AA2). Place furniture into position so both brackets (AA1) are vertically in the line.
4. Lace the end of the restraints strap through the larger hole in each bracket. Ensure the restraints strap with grids surface facing the inner loops. Bring both ends together and slide the flat end through the locking end and draw it through until all slack is removed.
5. Make sure that the strap is securely laced & locked.
