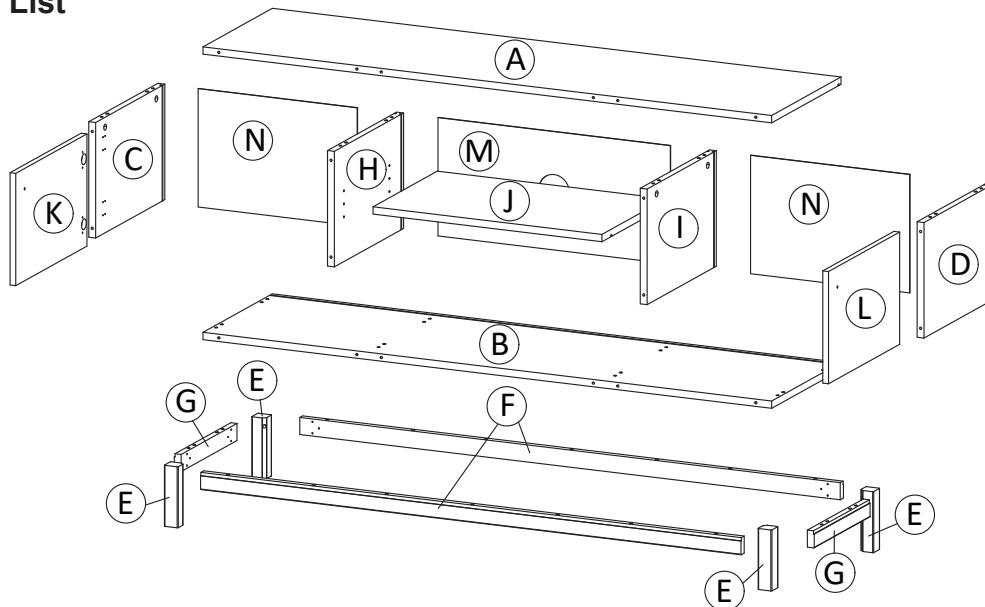

CARE AND MAINTENANCE

Always use felt pads under all articles to prevent discoloration or softening of the lacquer. Plastic and rubber bases on items can discolor wood. Wipe up spills immediately and avoid common hazards such as hot dishes, harsh solvents and abrasives. Cleaning should be done with a soft lint free cotton cloth dampened with water or furniture polish. On highly used surfaces we recommend applying a quality paste wax which should be used on a regular basis to provide additional protection from scratches and spills. How often you apply the wax depends on how much wear the furniture receives.

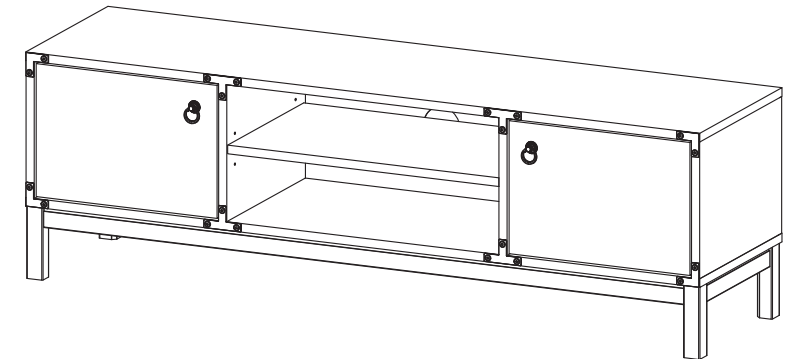

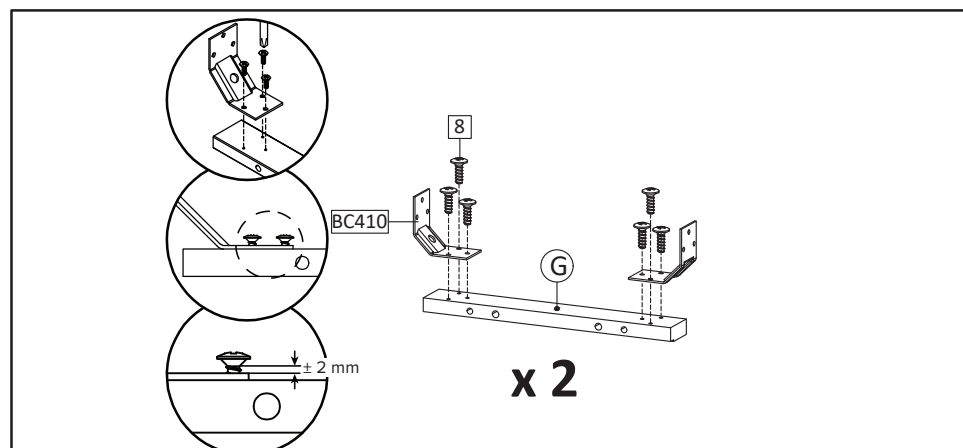
STEP1: Insert Cambolt (HW1) and Door Stopper (HW5) into Top Board (A). Insert Dowel (HW4) into Side Board Left (C), Side Board Right (D), Center Board Left (H) and Center Right (I).



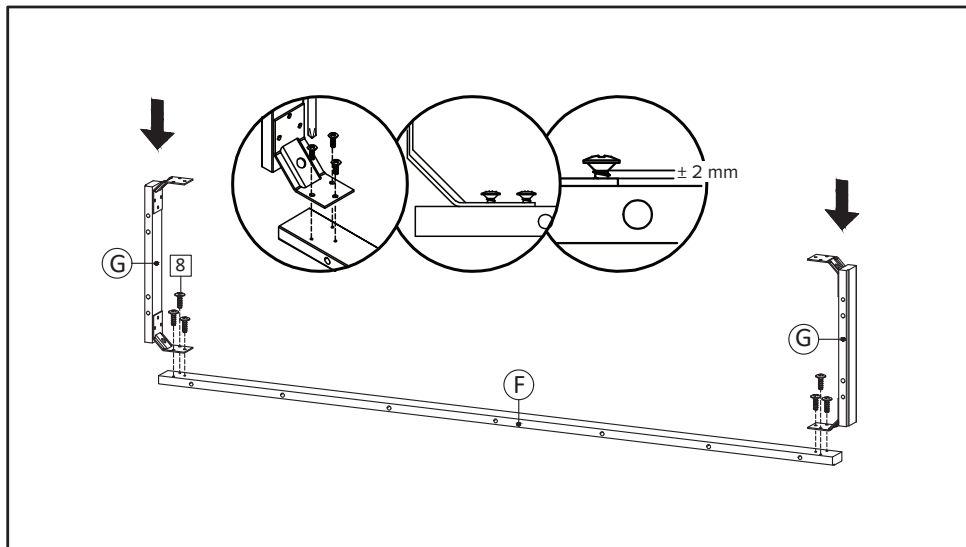
STEP2: Attach Side Board Left (C) , Side Board Right (D), Center Boards (H&I) into Top Board (A) . Insert Camlock (HW2) then tighten using screwdriver. Put Screw Cover (HW10) over the camlock.



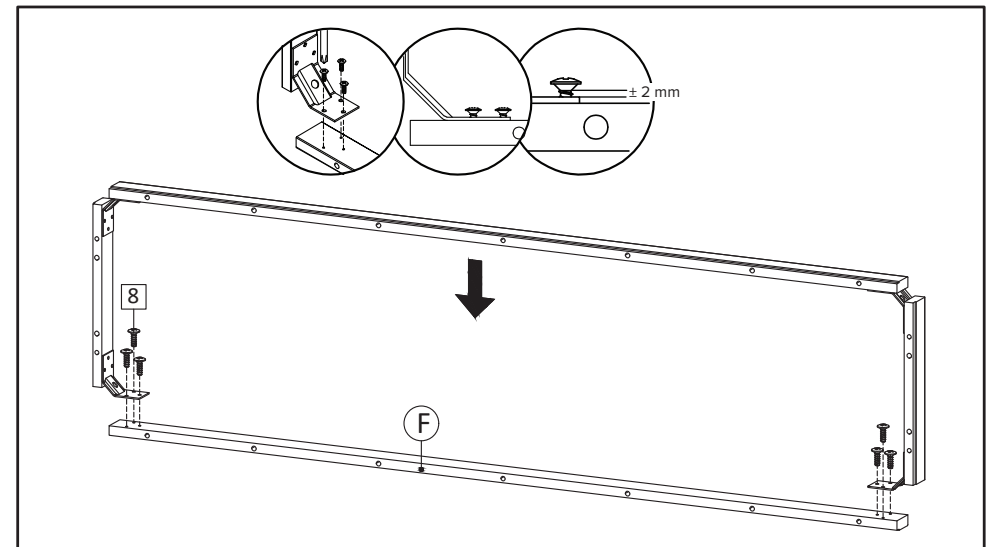
Step3: Insert Backboards (M&N) as figure. Put Bottom Board (B) and secure with Screw M7x50 (HW6), tighten screws using Allen Key (HW7)



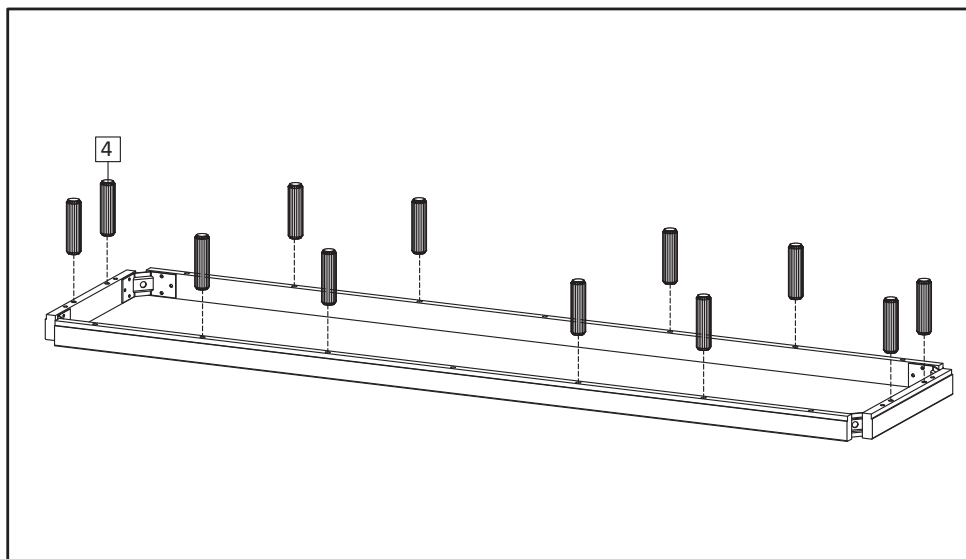
STEP4: Now let's combine the bottom skirt. Start with installing Corner Brace (HW BC410) into Bottom Skirt 2 (G) using Screw M4.5x12.5mm (HW8). Do not overtighten screw yet, leave around 2mm gap.



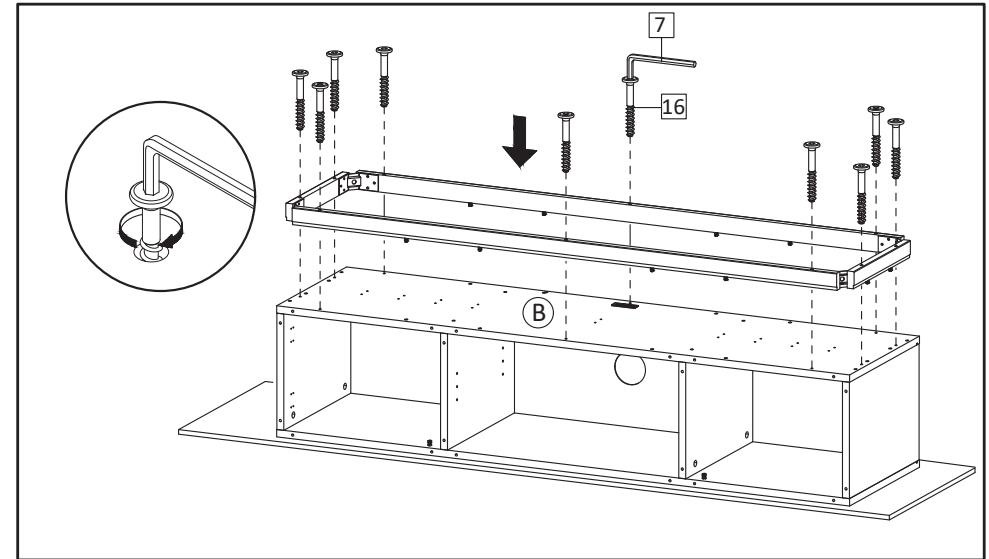
STEP5: Combine the Bottom Skirt 2 from step 4 with Bottom skirt 1 (F), using Screw M4.5x12.5mm (HW8). Do not overtighten screw yet, leave around 2mm gap.



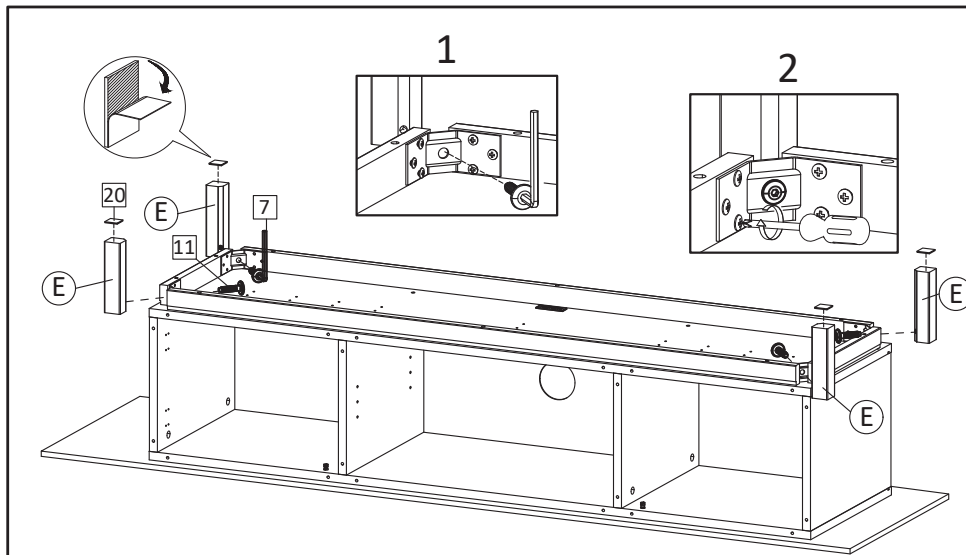
STEP6: Combine components from step 5 with remaining Bottom skirt 1 (F), using M4.5x12.5mm (HW8). Do not overtighten screw yet, leave around 2mm gap.



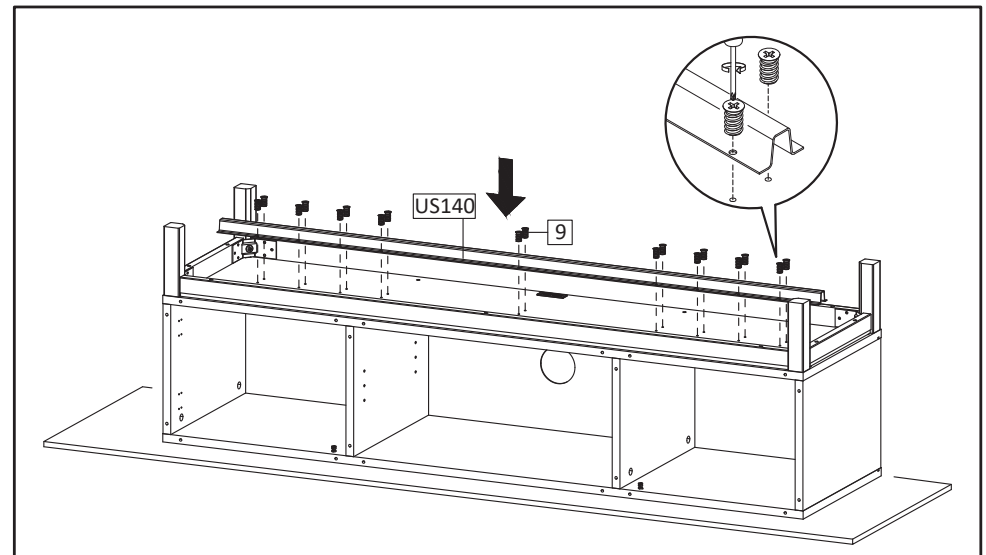
STEP7: Insert Dowel Big (HW4) into assembled Bottom skirt from previous step.



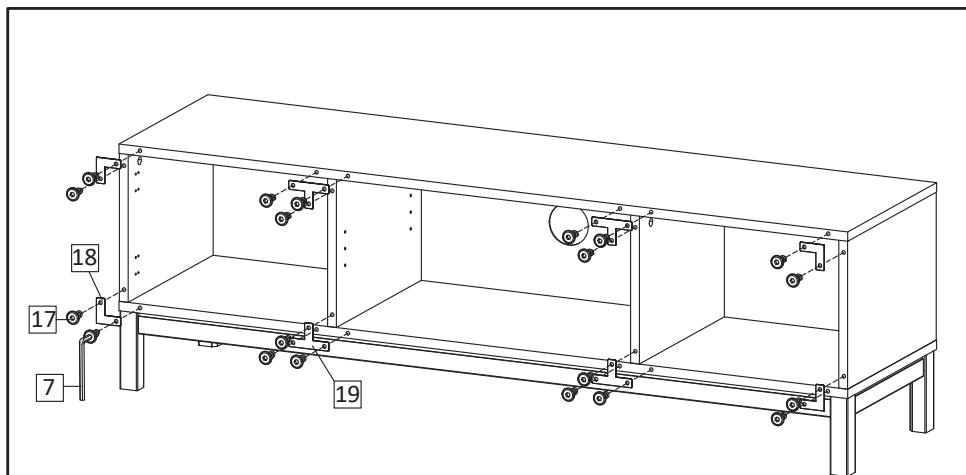
STEP8: Bring the assembled bottom skirt and insert into Bottom Board of the media stand. Secure the bottom skirt by inserting Screw M6.4x53mm (HW16) and tighten with Allen Key (HW7).



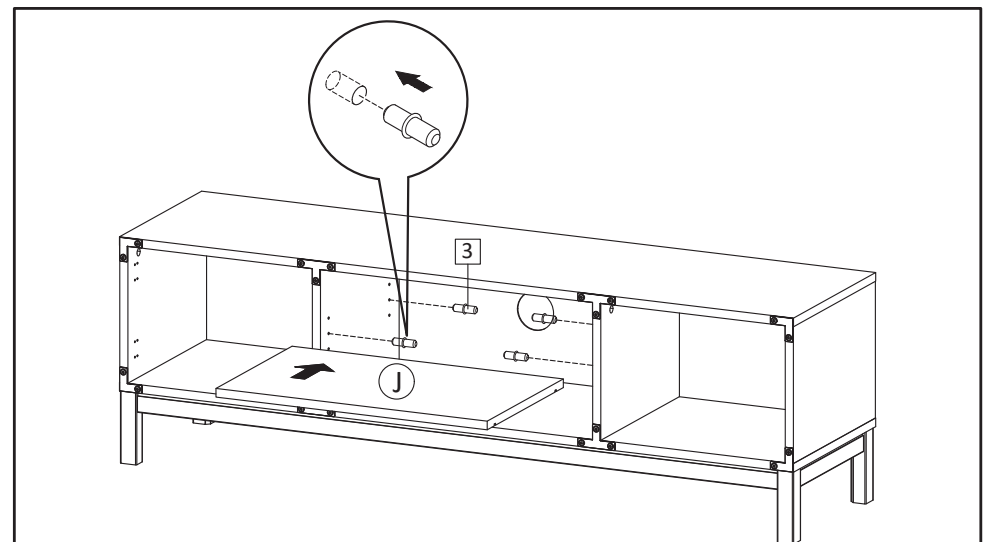
STEP9: Place the Leg (E) on the center corner brace and insert the screw M6x25mm (HW11) with Allen Key (HW7) into the leg, then tighten all the screws. Remove back paper of the floor protector (HW20) stick to bottom face of the legs.



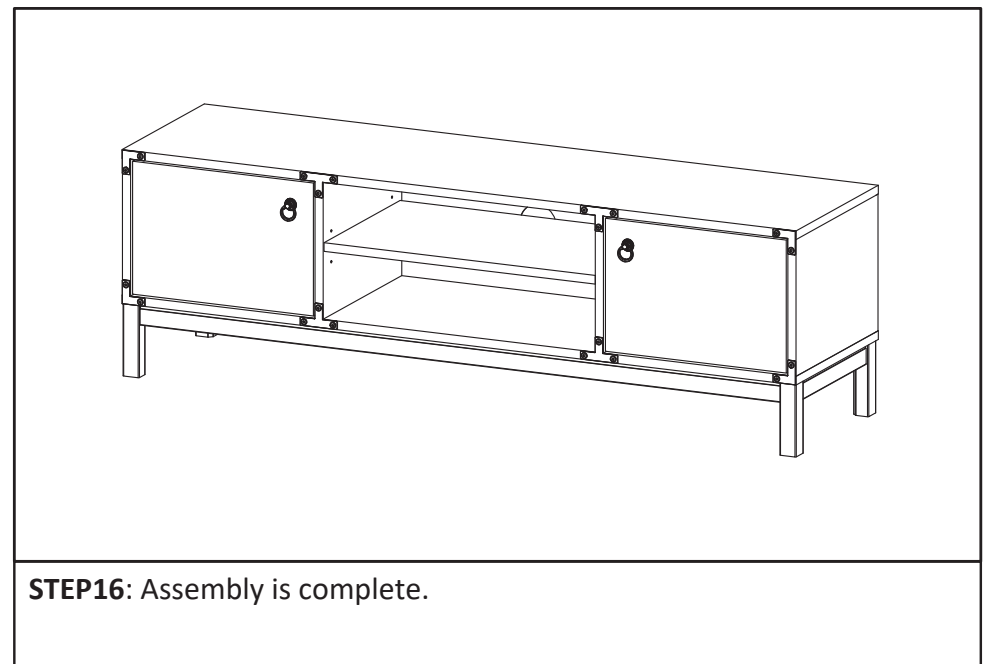
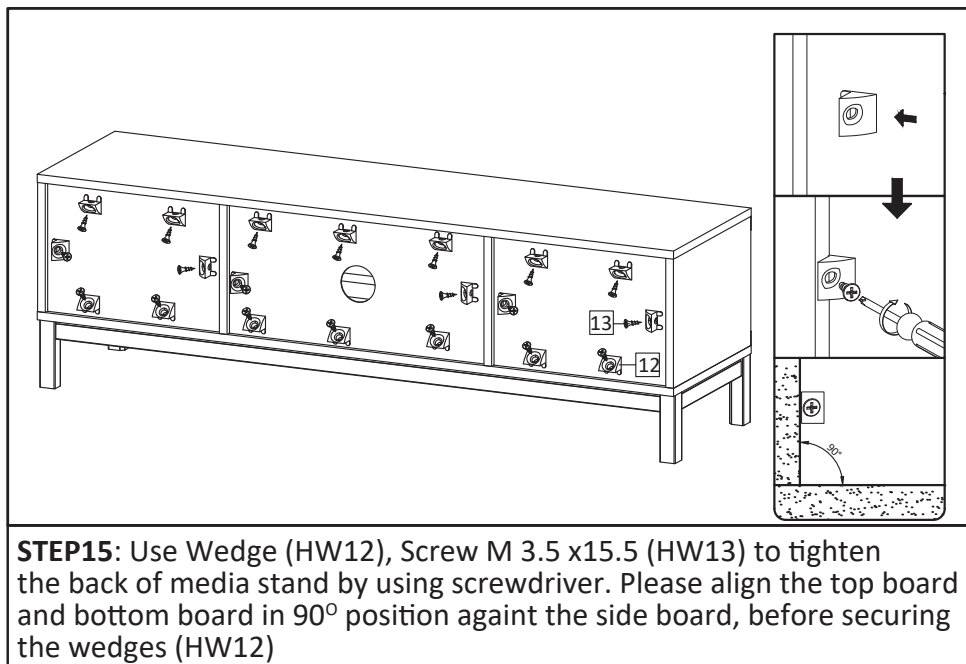
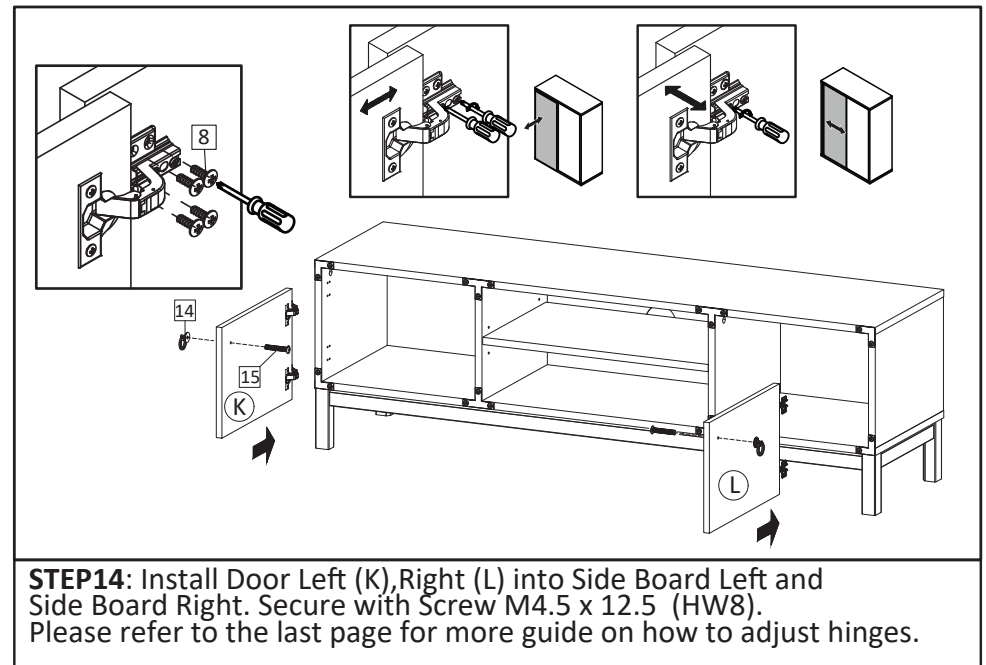
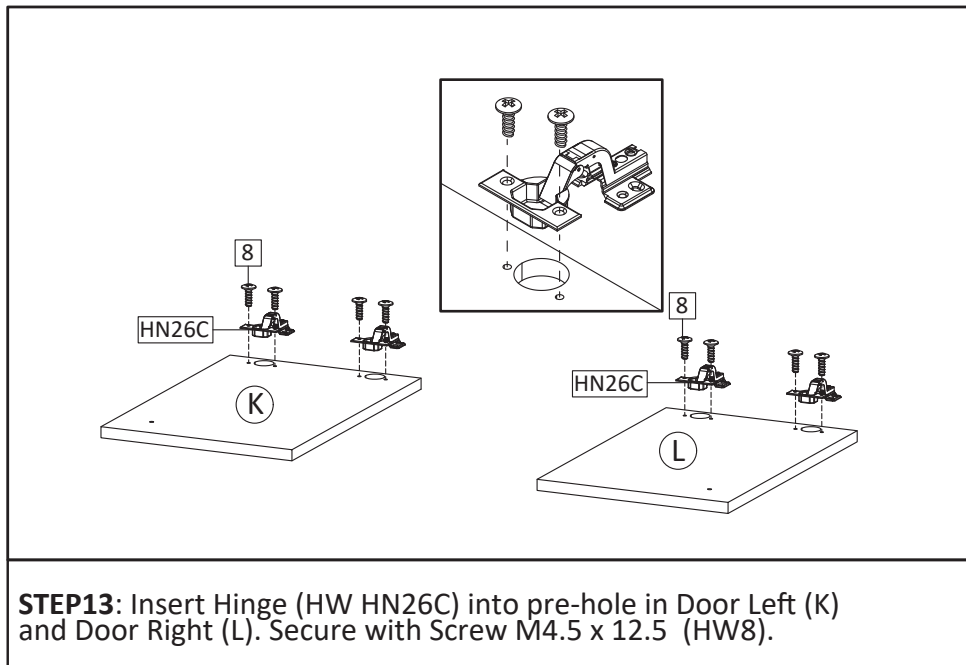
STEP10: Place Anti Deflection Metal Bar (HW US140) , secure with screw M 6 x12.5 (HW9) using screwdriver.



STEP11: Bring the media stand upright. Install Plat L (HW18), Plat T(HW19) into the provided holes at front edges of the media stand. Secure with screw M 6.4x14mm (HW17),tighten using Allen Key (HW7).



STEP12: insert Shelf Pin (HW3) into the between Centerboards on the desired level. Then place the Adjustable Shelf (J) onto the Shelf Pin.

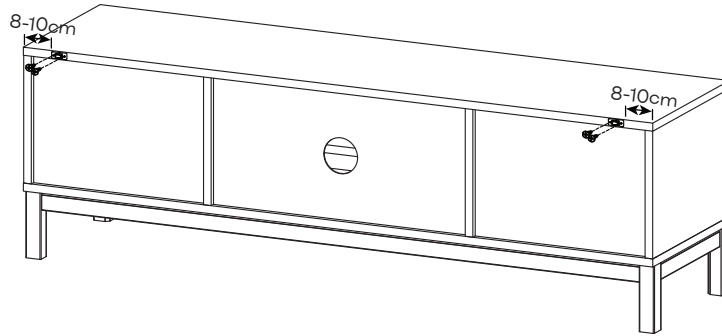
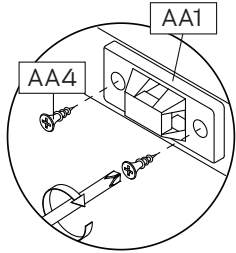
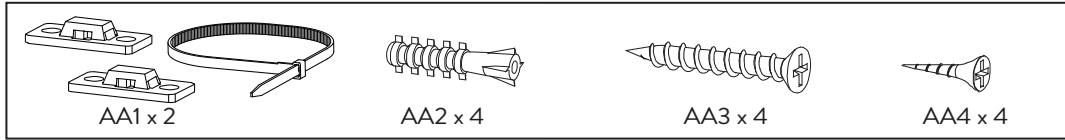

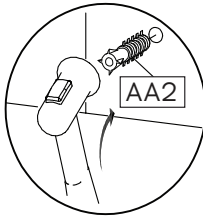
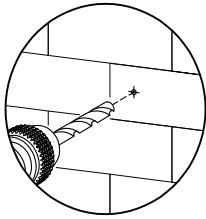
Different wall materials require unique wall fasteners.

The wall plugs (AA2) and screws (AA3) are designed for fixing to concrete walls only.

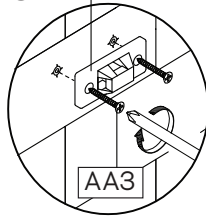

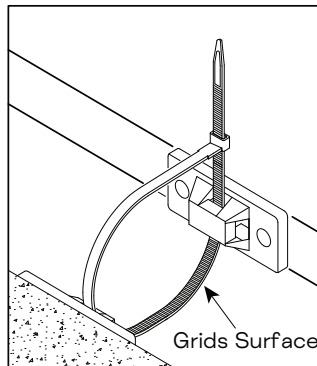
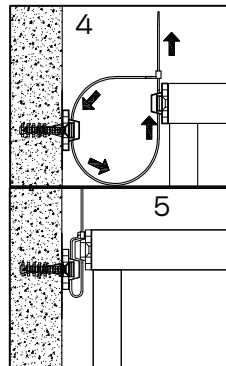
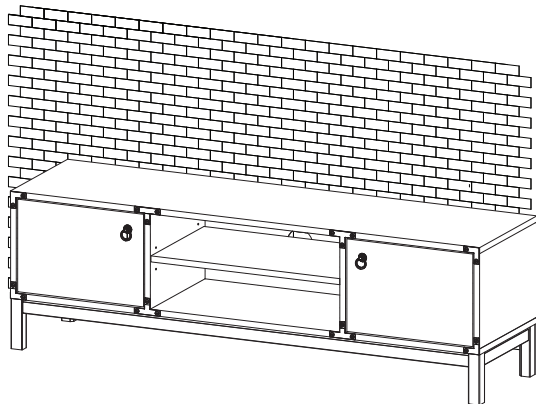
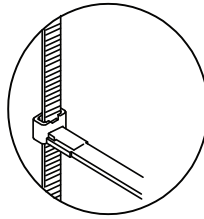
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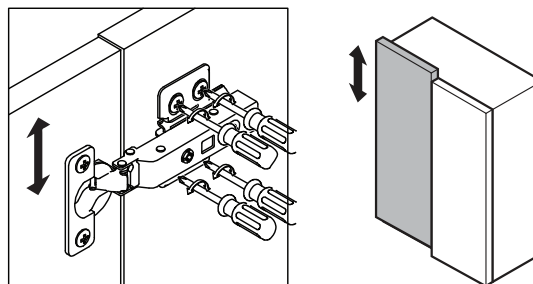
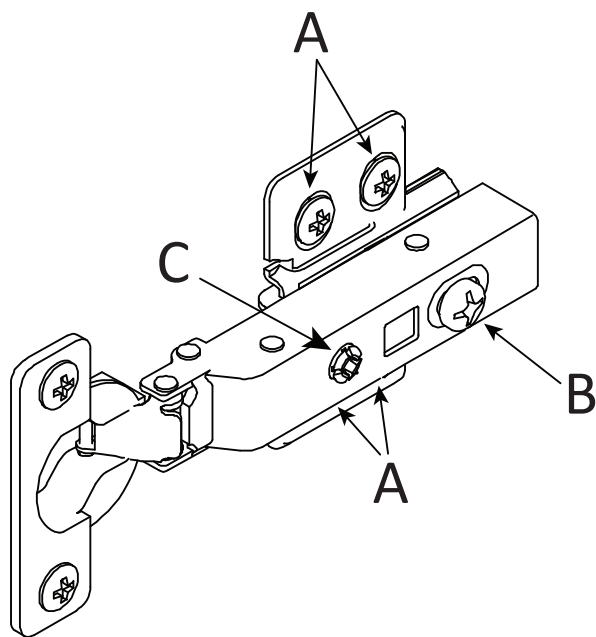
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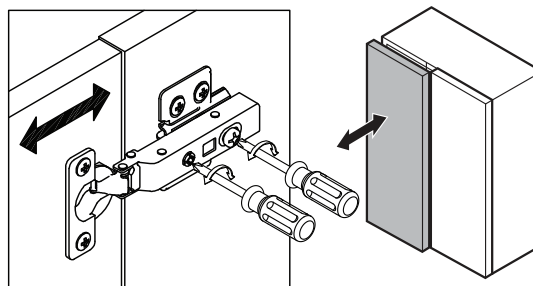


HOW TO ADJUST HINGES



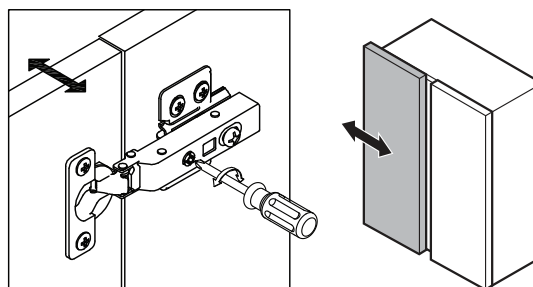
To adjust the vertical height.

Loosen the four screws "A" on both hinges. Two of them are usually in slotted holes which allows you to adjust up or down by few mm. Then tighten back up.



To adjust depth.

Loosen screw "B" and adjust door, if the door can not be adjusted, please loosen screw "C", then try again. Tighten screw "B" and "C".



To adjust side ways.

Turn the screw "C" on BOTH hinges on each door.
