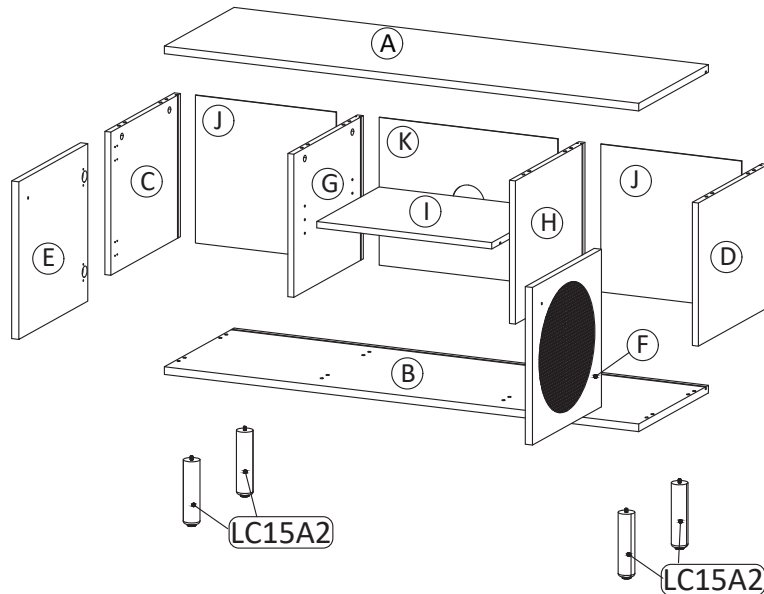

CARE AND MAINTENANCE

Always use felt pads under all articles to prevent discoloration or softening of the lacquer. Plastic and rubber bases on items can discolor wood. Wipe up spills immediately and avoid common hazards such as hot dishes, harsh solvents and abrasives. Cleaning should be done with a soft lint free cotton cloth dampened with water or furniture polish. On highly used surfaces we recommend applying a quality paste wax which should be used on a regular basis to provide additional protection from scratches and spills. How often you apply the wax depends on how much wear the furniture receives.

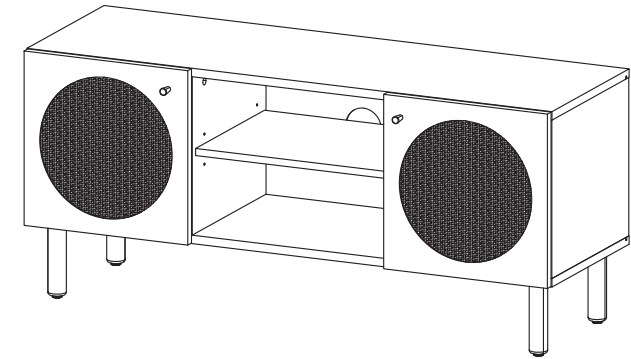

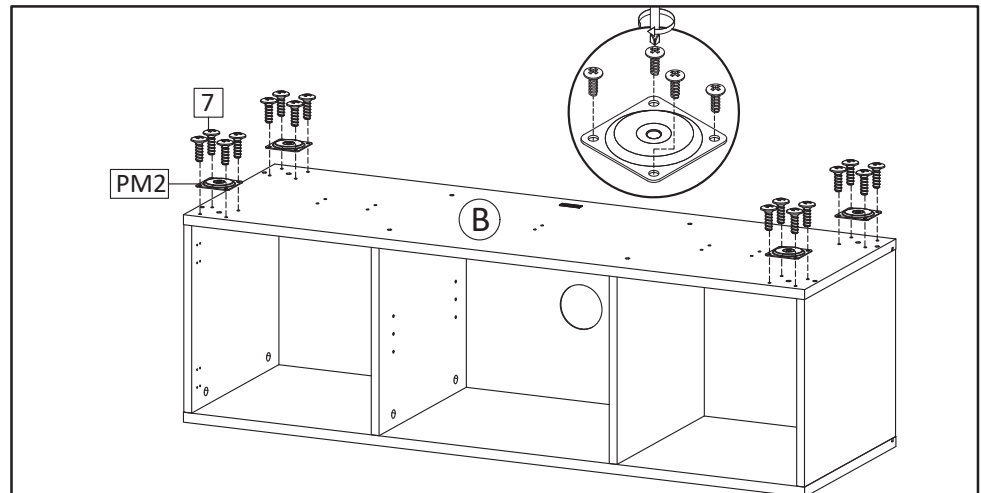
STEP1: Insert Cambolt (HW1) into Top Board (A).
Insert Dowel (HW4) into Side Board Left (C), Side Board Right (D),
Center Board Left (G) and Center Right (H).



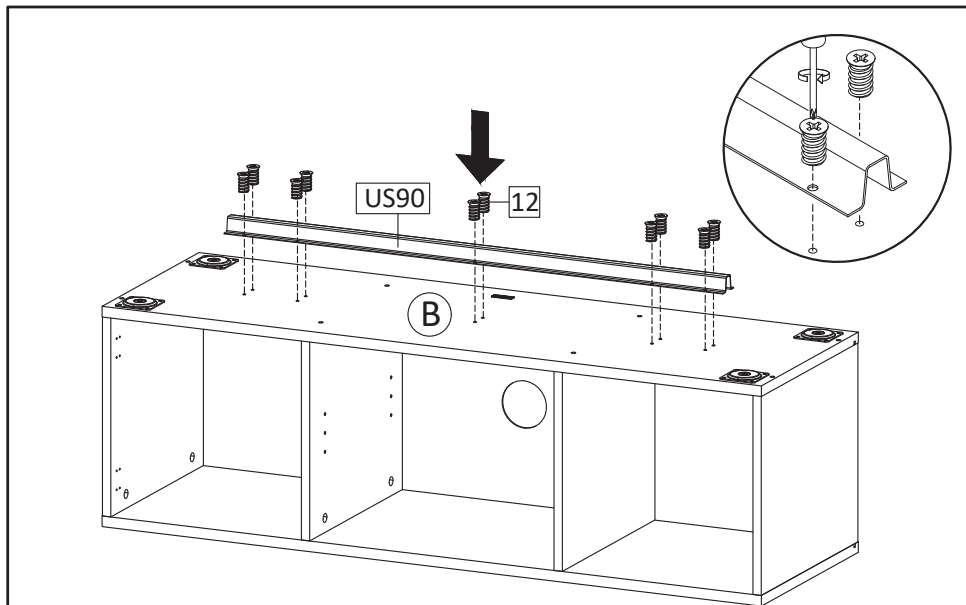
Step3: Insert Backboards (J&K) as figure. Put Bottom Board (B)
and secure with Screw M7x50 (HW5),
tighten screws using Allen Key (HW6).



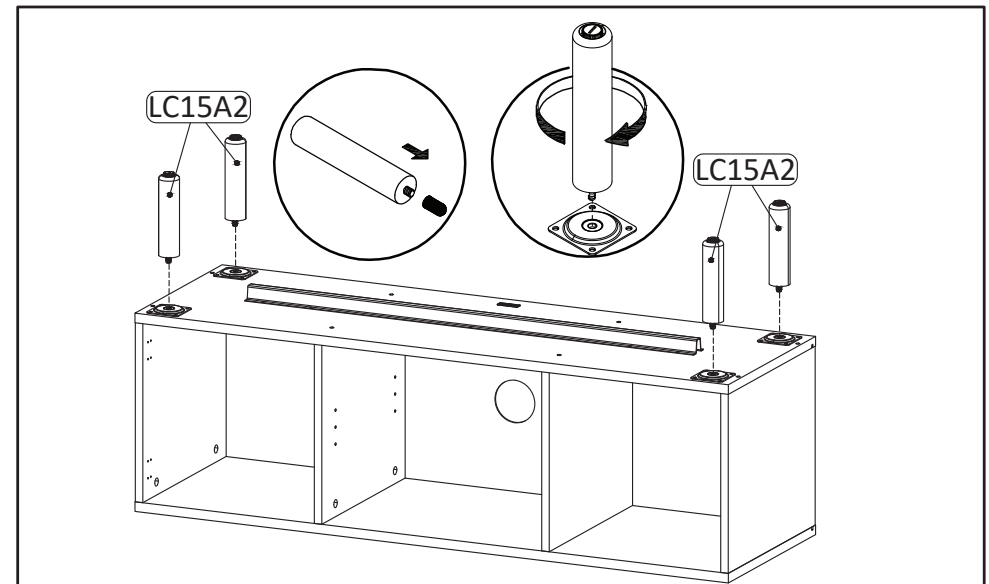
STEP2: Attach Side Board Left (C) , Side Board Right (D),
Center Boards (G&H) into Top Board (A) .
Insert Camlock (HW2) then tighten using screwdriver.
Put Screw Cap (HW3) over the camlock.



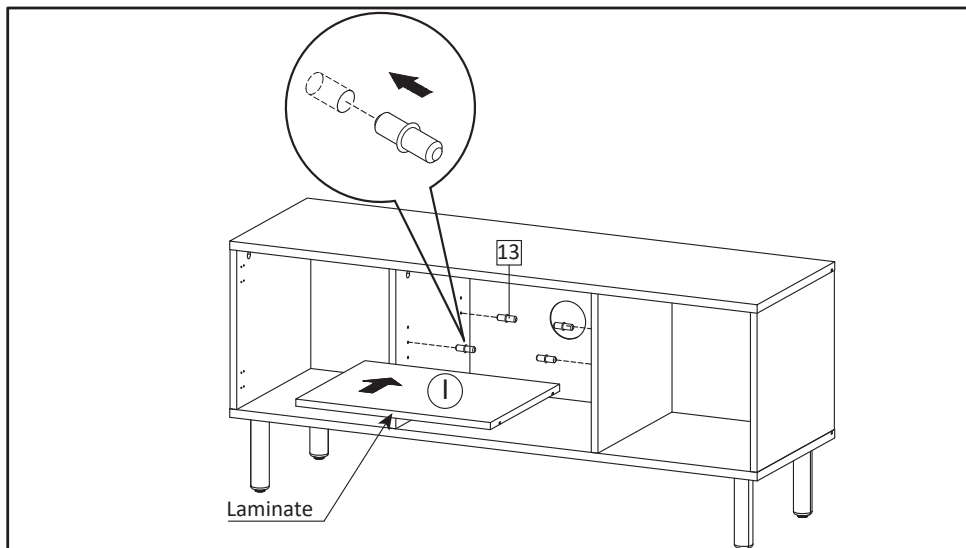
STEP4: Install Mounting Plate (PM2) and secure with
screw M4.5x12.5mm (HW7) on Bottom Board.



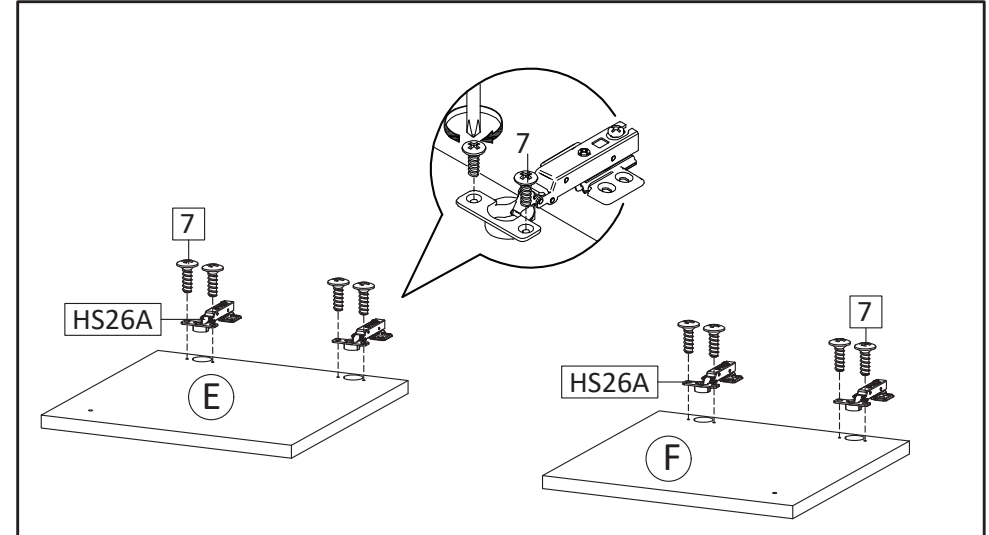
STEP5: Place Anti Deflection Metal Bar (HW US90) , secure with screw M 6 x12.5 (HW12) using screwdriver.



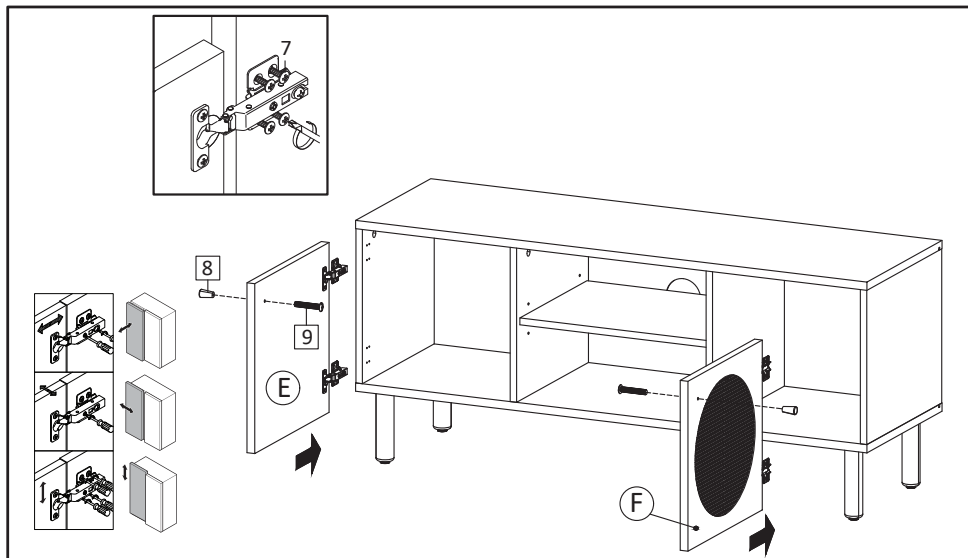
STEP6: Insert Leg (LC15A2) into Mounting Plate, tighten by rotating . the leg clockwise.



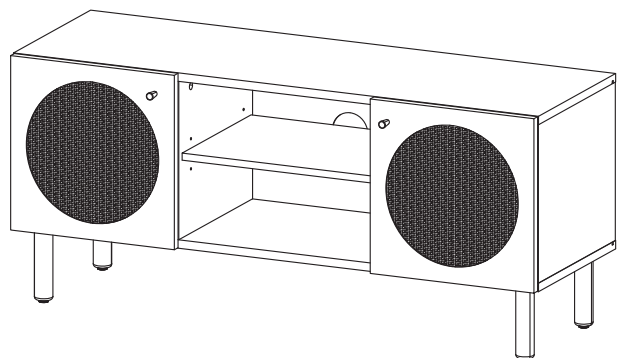
STEP7: insert Shelf Pin (HW13) into the between Center boards on the desired level. Then place the Adjustable Shelf (I) onto the Shelf Pin.



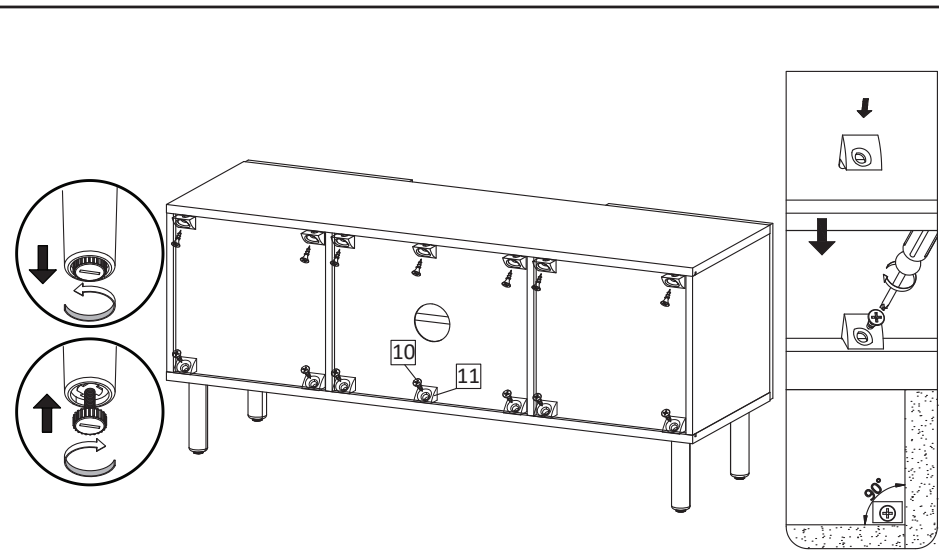
STEP8: Insert Hinge (HW HS26A) into pre-hole in Door Left (E) and Door Right (F). Secure with Screw M4.5 x12.5 (HW7).



STEP9: Install Door Left (E), into Side Board Left and install Door Right (F), into Side Board Right, Secure with Screw M4.5 x 12.5 (HW7). Please refer to the last page for more guide on how to adjust hinges. Insert Handle (HW8) and Screw M4x25 mm (HW9) into Doors.



STEP11: Assembly is complete.



STEP10: Use Wedge (HW11), Screw M 3.5 x15.5 (HW10) to tighten the back of media stand by using screwdriver. Please align the top board and bottom board in 90° position against the side board, before securing the wedges (HW11).

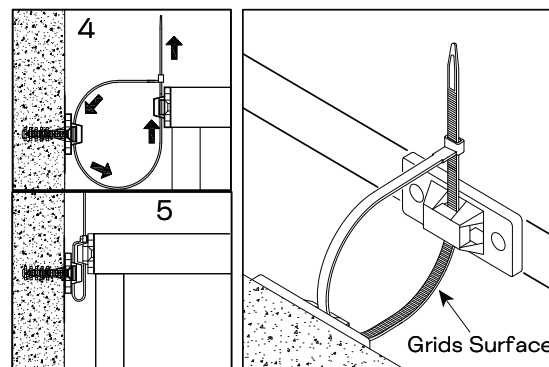
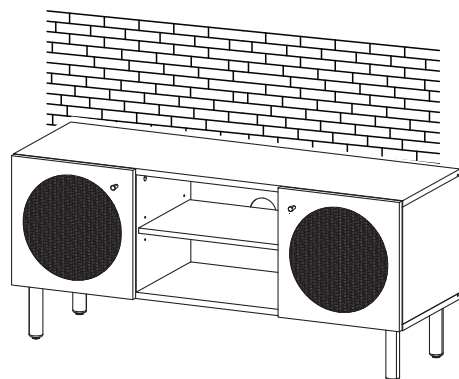
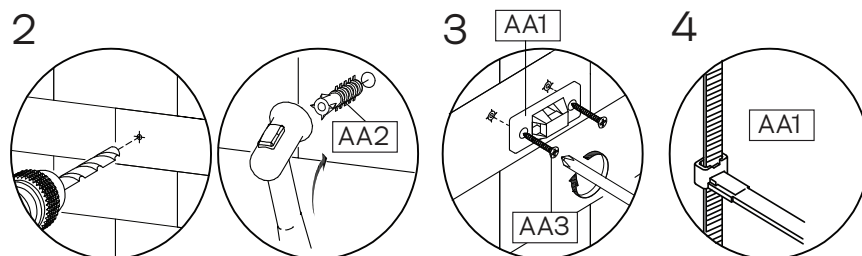
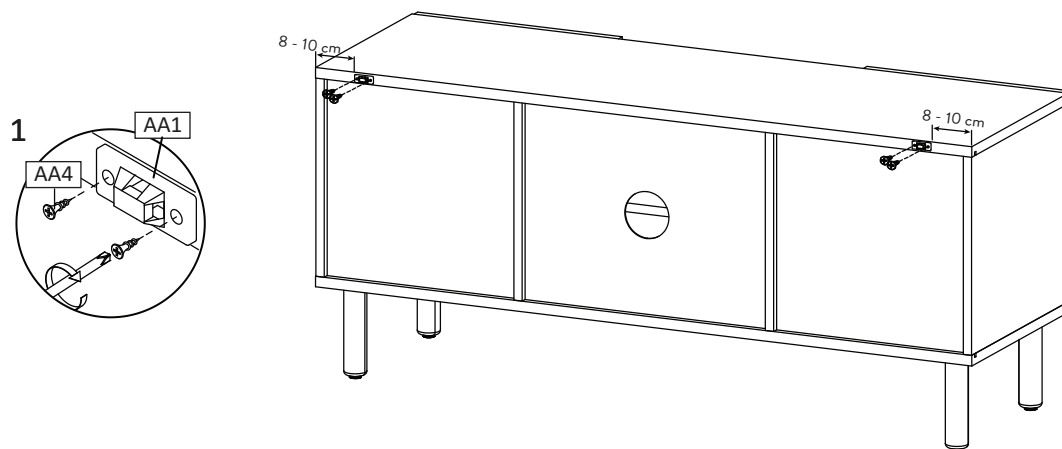
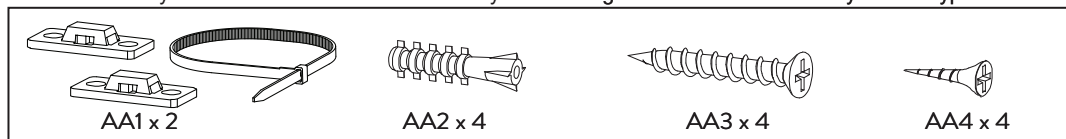
Place your furniture on level floor. The legs come with adjustable leveller, adjust it as needed until your furniture sit steady on the floor.

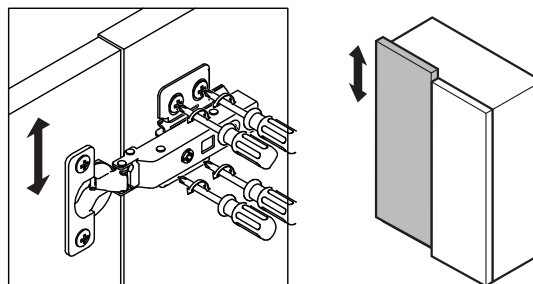
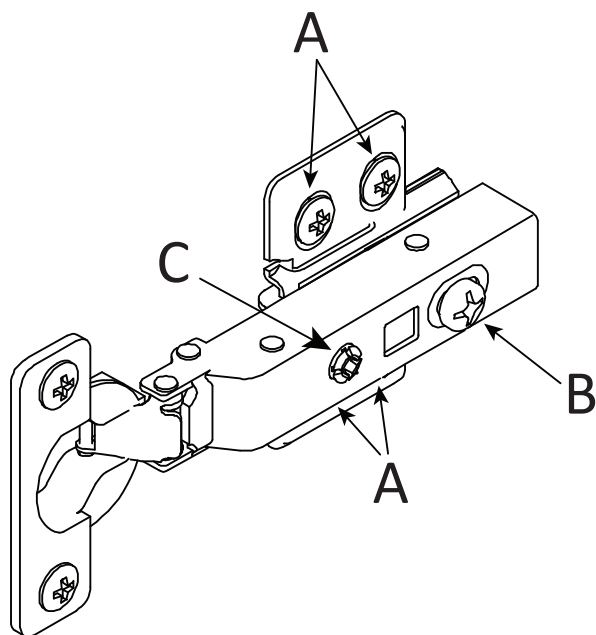
Different wall materials require unique wall fasteners.

Please consult your local hardware store to ensure you are using the correct hardware for your wall type.

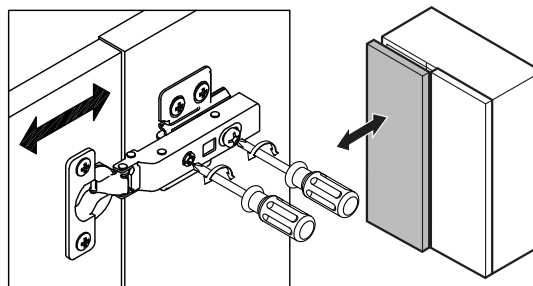


HOW TO ADJUST HINGES



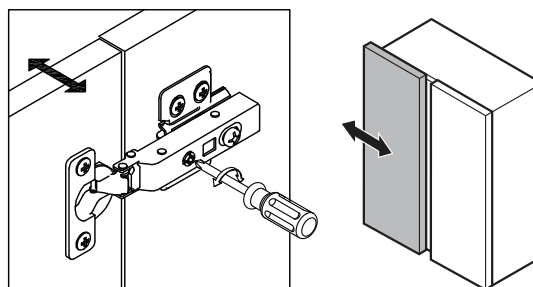
To adjust the vertical height.

Loosen the four screws "A" on both hinges. Two of them are usually in slotted holes which allows you to adjust up or down by few mm. Then tighten back up.



To adjust depth.

Loosen screw "B" and adjust door, if the door can not be adjusted, please loosen screw "C", then try again. Tighten screw "B" and "C".



To adjust side ways.

Turning the screw "C" on BOTH hinges on each door.
