

CAMP HELEN STATE PARK BEACH



It is an ecologically impressive beach with the combination of freshwater and saltwater coming from the Gulf of Mexico, Lake Powell, and Phillips Inlet. Those who enjoy white-sand beaches with undisturbed natural beauty will appreciate this beach.

SCHOONERS BEACH

The beach scene at Schooners is laid-back, with beach volleyball, socializing on the deck of the oceanfront patio, and hanging out by the water. There is often live music to set the scene for the swimming and surfing down by the water.



ST. ANDREWS STATE BEACH

Besides swimming in the Gulf waters, St. Andrews State Park Beach is great for snorkeling in the clear shallow waters behind the jetties. This beach is popular for visitors who want to head out for a day of scuba diving, canoeing, and kayaking.

DOG BEACH

The best pet-friendly spot for water recreation. The beach is located near Russell-Fields Pier, with 400 feet of white sand and oceanfront space dedicated to dogs and their owners who are out to enjoy the sun while on vacation.

HOST RECOMMENDATIONS

- Ride your bike along the Timpoochee Trail. Stop and shop or grab an ice cream in one of the many shops you'll pass along the trail.
- Pier Park
 It's the place to shop the beachy boutiques, get fruity drinks, and indulge in beachfront restaurants. There is even a Ferris Wheel!
- Panama City Beach Winery
 Stop by for a free tasting and take a bottle or two to the beach with you.
- Shipwreck Island Waterpark, Ripley's Believe It Or Not, or Ride Go Carts at Race City@
 - Lagoon Pontoon
 Rent a pontoon for half or full day and see dolphins (the earlier, the better) Their double deckers even have water slides!
- Conservation Park
 a 2,900 acre park that has 12 different trails that range
 from 0.6 miles to 11 miles. Guided Audobon bird walks are
 available.
- Have a beach bonfire with Endless Beach Rentals. They will set up everything for you (from chairs to hammocks to a stocked cooler!) They even clean up everything for you!
- Sea Dragon Pirate Cruise
 Board an 85' pirate ship and party with pirates' festive
 music, games, and you may even get a share of the loot
 after the cruise.
