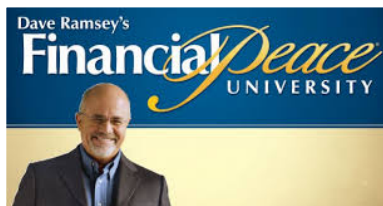
A-E: 2 lb bags of flour or boxes of Bisquick
