How to access course materials and the livestream for courses

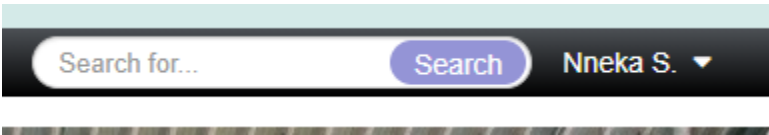
Step #1: Go to <https://www.eventscribe.net/2021/SMFM21/>. The page you come to will look like one of the two screenshots below.



Step #2: Click on the login button at the top right of your screen. You will be directed to smfm.org to enter your login credentials.

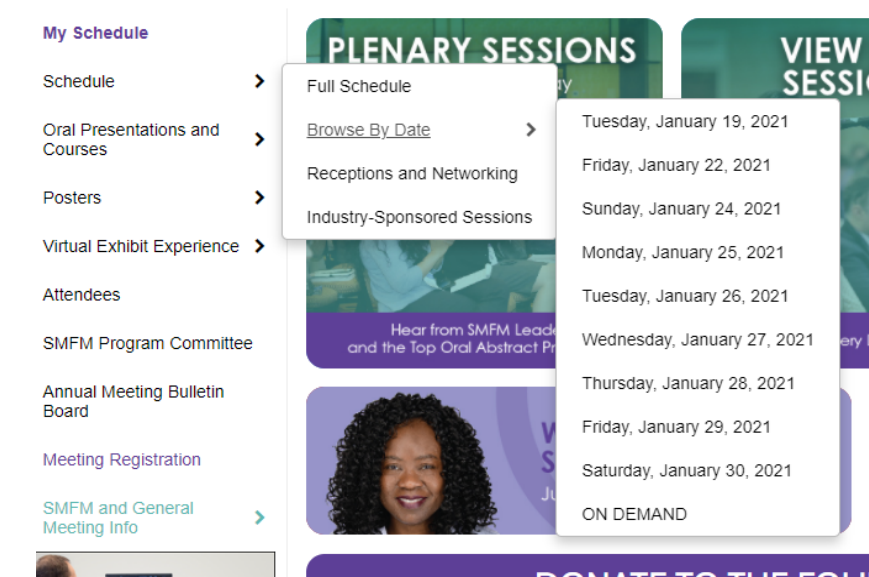

Step #3: After entering your login credentials, you will be redirected back to the virtual meeting site landing page; however, now your name will show at the top of the page instead of “Login.”

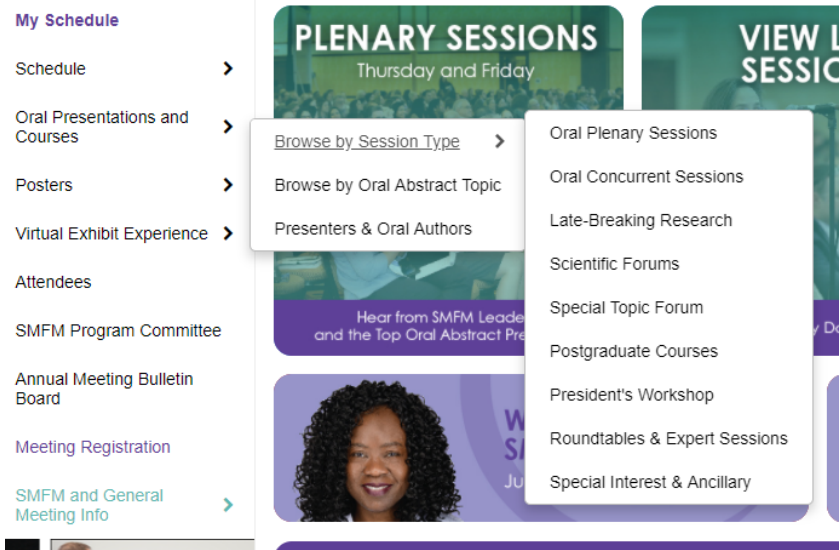
