

GARLIC: FRIEND OR FOE?

arlic (Allium sativum) has been valued for thousands of years for its medicinal purposes. Five thousand year old Sanskrit and Chinese medical manuscripts describe the benefits of garlic. Today, garlic is grown all over the world and is making a strong comeback as a potent, effective, natural remedy.

Garlic is a member of the lily family and of the same genus as the onion. Garlic has been used for thousands of years as a medicinal herb; in fact, Hippocrates advocated garlic for infections, cancer and digestive disorders. The great Roman naturalist,

Pliny the Elder, also recommended garlic for a wide variety of ailments, ranging from the common cold to epilepsy and cancer.

Modern science has also established the fact that garlic boosts immunity, gets rid of bacterial, viral and fungal infections, enhances liver function, helps detoxify the cells in the body, lowers cholesterol and triglycerides in the blood and even fights cancer.

Raw garlic cloves contain a high amount of a compound called alliin, as well as the enzyme alliinase. When garlic is crushed or diced, the alliin comes into contact with the alliinase enzyme and the compound allicin is formed. Cooked garlic is not nearly as therapeutic as freshly crushed or finely diced raw garlic.

Knowledge is a powerful thing, but astute pet owners should gather all the data about garlic before shunning this celebrated bulb.

Ironically, garlic is approved as a flavoring, spice or seasoning for use in pet food, yet the FDA has listed garlic in its poisonous plant database. That's because a study suggested that when garlic is fed in excessive quantities (5 grams of whole garlic per kilogram of the dog's body weight), it might cause damage to the red blood cells of dogs.

Considering the data presented in this study, the average 75-pound Golden Retriever would need to eat five full heads of garlic or about 75 cloves of gar-

lic in each meal before there would

be any adverse effect on the red blood cells. Similarly, a dog weighing a mere 10 lbs would need to eat 25 grams of garlic – about half an entire head of garlic, or about 6 to 8 garlic cloves in every meal to experience any adverse effects.

How many dogs do you know who would either be given or would want to eat that many cloves of garlic? Drinking too much water can kill you, but we all drink water. In fact, we all know that drinking water is a healthy thing to do. So what's healthy and what's too much? It's obvious that all this "garlic is bad for your dog" hype has been taken totally out of context.

Furthermore, the total reported adverse affects from garlic add up to a non-event over the past 22 years. The National Animal Supplement Council responsibly records both Adverse Events and Serious Adverse Events resulting from the use of natural products.

A Serious Adverse Event is defined as: "An Adverse Event with a transient incapacitating effect

A Victim of Poor Press

Recently, the safety of garlic for dogs has come into question. That's because one research study used a huge amount of garlic in their test dogs. When garlic is fed in very large amounts to dogs, it can cause oxidative damage to red blood cells, leading to a medical situation called Heinz body anemia.

(i.e. rendering the animal unable to function normally for a short period of time, such as with a seizure) or non-transient (i.e. permanent) health effect." 900 million doses of garlic over a 22 year time span resulted in only two Serious Adverse Events and these episodes could very well have been due not to garlic, but to another ingredient in the mix. This proves beyond a shadow of a doubt that the risk of using garlic is so low that it's statistically insignificant.

It's Time to Reconsider Garlic

What is significant is all the positive research delineating the medicinal powers of garlic. Among garlic's reputed benefits, perhaps the best known is its natural antibiotic activity, with reports going back through history. In fact, Pasteur noted garlic's antibacterial benefits in 1858. Modern researchers have compared the effectiveness of garlic with that of antibiotics and have found that garlic has a broad spectrum antibacterial effect. Additionally, bacteria don't seem to build up a resistance to garlic as they do to many modern antibiotics.

But that's not all. Garlic increases the immune activity of Killer Cells (cells that seek out and kill invading bacteria and cancer cells). Uncooked garlic also helps lower blood triglycerides and cholesterol, making it useful for certain breeds (Schnauzers and Beagles) that are predisposed to this problem.

A 1988 study found that diallyl sulfide, a compound in garlic, prevented tumor formation in rats. Other studies have shown that garlic inhibits various forms of cancer growth in the body. Garlic also enhances overall liver function and triggers enzyme responses to help break down waste materials before they go into the bloodstream. In other words, garlic helps the liver out – and in today's toxic world, our dogs' livers need all the help they can get.

Additionally, garlic has been fed to dogs to help prevent flea infestations. There are many products on the market containing garlic for this very purpose. Both powdered and raw garlic are effective, although raw garlic has significantly more health benefits.

How to Prepare Garlic

To release its medicinal properties, garlic first has to go through a chemical process so the allicin can be created. It's best to finely chop or crush the garlic clove, then wait a few minutes to allow the chemical reaction to occur. The healing allicin is unstable when exposed to air and heat, so don't wait more than 20 minutes before you top your dog's meal with some healthy raw garlic.

A host of studies provide evidence that the allicin in garlic works to inhibit cancer formation.

With cancer being the number one cause of death in dogs in the United States, let's all get going with garlic! Buy a garlic press or simply chop some up. You can then mix it in with your dog's meal.

While cooking garlic destroys allicin, other components in cooked or powdered garlic continue to provide some benefits to your dog's health. The cooked garlic will still function as an antioxidant and help flush toxins out. If you cook meals for your dog, it's totally fine to add garlic as a flavoring and for improved health.

EPA: SPOT-ON PESTICIDES LINKED TO PET DEATH

Adverse reactions to topical flea and tick products prompt an EPA investigation.

Des your dog's flea and tick solution include warnings of potential side effects, such as skin ulceration, vomiting, diarrhea, and even death? If you are using a spot-on formula for flea and tick control, it probably should.

Since 2009, the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) has been investigating topical or "spot-on" pesticides for pets in response to 44,000 complaints made to the EPA regarding the safety of these products in 2008 alone. Spot-on pesticides are chemicals applied from a small tube directly onto the pet, typically on the back of the neck, to

control fleas and ticks. Because spot-on products are not given orally or by injection, they do not fall under the jurisdiction of the Food & Drug Administration (FDA); rather, they are under the supervision of EPA as a pesticide.

The EPA communicated its findings within its first report in 2010, which included the following effects found among dogs treated with spot-on chemicals: "Clinical signs included such effects as vomiting, diarrhea, salivation, itching, hair loss, skin ulceration, lethargy, nervousness, ataxia, tremors, and seizure. Although most incidents were classified minor, all products had some deaths..."

The report found that inert ingredients used to aid in the application and dispersal of the pesticide might be the actual source of the harmful effects, rather than the pesticides themselves. The EPA concluded that negative side effects were more prevalent in smaller breeds and that dog weight is very



important in determining the proper dosage.

The EPA is continuing to monitor spot-on products for additional safety determinations. The findings of the 2010 report led to immediate changes in how the agency regulates these products and how companies label their products and report issues. Manufacturers now will be required to make packaging and labeling changes to help consumers provide safe dosages. Also, manufacturers will no longer be able to interchange the inert ingredients. The EPA is also making changes to how it regulates spot-on products, including the use of the FDA's requirements for pre-market clinical trials.

For some veterinarians and dog owners, these new measures are not enough. According to Dr. Karen Becker of the Healthy Pets website, "In my opinion, the risks of these products are simply too great to warrant their routine (monthly) use. I encourage my dog and cat owner clients to avoid these pesticides in favor of safer alternatives."


Study Proves Garlic Is Safe for Dogs

A study in Japan found that a harmful dose of garlic in dogs is nearly impossible to reach.

Japanese study from 2000 indicated that garlic might cause anemia in dogs, but it also found that it would take an insane amount of garlic to get there. Sadly, this study is often cited by dog owners and even some veterinarians as proof that garlic is unsafe for dogs. The facts of the experiment reveal the exact opposite. The researchers had to go far beyond the amount of garlic a dog might consume in a real-world situation to reach a barely measurable side effect.

The study

In the Japanese study, four dogs were fed a whopping half pound of garlic (equal to about 78 cloves), per 100 lbs. of body weight, every day for seven consecutive days. That equates to a total of about $3^{1/2}$ pounds (546 cloves) in one week.



The toxicity of any substance is dose-dependent. Water is healthy, but drinking excessive amounts of water can lead to fatal hyponatremia (i.e., water intoxication). Just like water, **garlic is perfectly safe** under ordinary usage.



Above is actual amount of garlic, fed to each dog every day for a week, that it takes to induce a measurable side effect in the blood, according to the study.

The results

Microscopic examination of the subject dogs' blood showed oxidative damage to a small percentage of red blood cells. No dog was reported to show sickness, weakness, or other negative signs. However, researchers did see hematologic characteristics that indicated that continued feeding of megadoses of raw garlic could eventually cause anemia; however, it is important to emphasize that none of the study dogs actually became anemic.

What does this all mean for those of us who give our dogs garlic?

Fortunately, there is virtually no scenario in which a dog would voluntarily eat the amount of raw garlic necessary to reach the dose used by the Japanese research team. Most natural veterinarians who recommend feeding raw garlic stay well under 10 percent of that amount.

Raw garlic, as was used in the study, contains about eight times the amount of allicin (the oxidative compound) found in air-dried garlic. **Springtime** uses an air-dried form of garlic for our **Bug Off Garlic** products, making it virtually impossible to overfeed. You would have to feed more than 4 lbs. of **Bug Off Garlic** per 100 lbs. of body weight every day for at least a week to reach the dose that was used in the study. Normal usage is less than 1 percent of that amount. That is why **Bug Off Garlic** is absolutely safe for everyday, year-round use.

SUPER CREEPY

Imagine a type of spider that craves human blood and will probably bite you and even your pets at some point in your life. Ticks are classified as arachnids. Yep, that's right - ticks are part of the same family as spiders.



SUPER STALKERS

Most hard-shelled ticks stalk their prey on well worn pathways (e.g., deer paths). Contrary to popular belief, ticks don't typically drop on prey from overhead trees. Instead, they find a vantage point, like a blade of tall grass, hold tightly on to it with their third and fourth pair of legs, and then stretch out their first pair of legs to snag an unlucky victim passing by.



SUPER SENSES

The same pair of legs they use to latch onto prey are equipped with super senses to detect their next meal. Some research has concluded that ticks can also identify shadows of their prey.

Ticks will often crawl around until they find a suitable picnic spot, perhaps a tasty ear or nice warm armpit. Then they settle in for a feast. The slow feeding can last several days, in which time the tick can suck 5 to 10 times their bodyweight in blood. The tick's saliva contains a neurotoxin with anesthetic properties, so the prey doesn't feel the bite or the feeding, enabling the tick to go days without detection.



SUPER INFECTIOUS

Through their saliva, ticks transmute infectious diseases, such as Lyme, Rocky Mountain Spotted Fever, Rickettsiosis, and more. In addition, if a tick is disturbed, it will regurgitate its stomach contents back into its host's bloodstream as well. This is very dangerous, as ticks can carry many different infectious pathogens, toxins, bacteria, viruses, protozoa and spirochetes, which can all be transmitted with a single bite. There are several tools and techniques to effectively remove ticks.



SUPER HARD TO KILL

Some ticks can make it up to 584 days without food. In the winter when prey is scarce, some ticks can go dormant (stasis) until the spring, when they re-awaken to resume the hunt. Water does not kill them easily, as they have an amazingly low respiratory rate. This is why they will often survive being flushed out into the sewer system. They can easily survive laundry washing, although the dryer should kill them. Even the spot-on tick pesticides commonly given to pets are not 100% effective at killing ticks, not to mention that they come with serious pet health risks. This is why more and more pet owners are turning to natural alternatives, such as garlic, to repel ticks before they bite.

Garlic Puts Flies Off Their Feed

y horses will be getting grain seasoned with garlic this fly season. I had heard and read of how adding garlic to a horse's feed would discourage flies from biting them. Late last summer I saw it for myself.

A number of us went on a daylong trail ride through the mountains. As usual, I covered my horse with a long-acting fly spray. I also used a rollon insect repellent inside her ears and around her eyes. I had applied enough that I felt we rode trailing an insecticide cloud behind us. It was a warm day, so the horses sweated a bit. We also crossed a couple of creeks that came up to the horses' bellies. My mare was stomping her feet and swishing her tail when we tied up for lunch because the fly spray had washed off her legs. I applied more and touched up the roll-on in her ears and around her eyes. I always carry bug spray in my saddle bags.

The real test came at the end of the ride as we gathered in a circle on our horses to discuss our next ride. Four of the five horses were tail swishing and hoof stomping. Dillon, Jane's gelding, stood dozing quietly.

I asked what kind of bug spray she uses and was told she hadn't even purchased a bottle of spray that year. She had switched from insecticide to garlic because Dillon was especially allergic to all types of insects and broke out in welts at every bite. She needed something that worked 24/7.

Jane's herbal choice is **Bug Off Garlic**, avail-

able through **Springtime** (Phone: 800-521-3212, website: springtimeinc.com). There are dozens of other brands available and they may be just as good. I'm going with this one because I've seen it in action.

There have been some rumblings that an excess of garlic can cause anemia in horses. My vets say it would take a lot and advise using garlic supplements as directed, to be safe.

I'd kind of expected a horse treated with garlic to smell like a pizza, but Dillon just smelled like a horse. The **Springtime** catalog said parasitic insects have a sense of smell 10,000 time stronger than a human's. That may explain why Dillon attracted no flies, ticks, mosquitoes, or gnats.

Jane estimated the cost of the garlic supplement was about \$50 per horse per season. She starts feeding it in May and continues through September. I probably spend that much in bug spray.

The other benefit is that garlic is a whole lot less potentially toxic than many of the insecticides. I'd certainly opt to use it for mares nursing foals.

As always, ask your vet before starting any additive program. Mine has already given the thumbs-up to **Bug Off**. Besides, I just love the name.

Garlic safety:

Springtime has sold literally tons of garlic a year for over 20 years, and in that time, we have talked to plenty of customers concerning garlic's efficacy, health benefits, and safety for both dogs and horses. There is a lot of misunderstanding about garlic, and most of the confusion stems from a single study in Japan where four dogs were force-fed extremely large amounts of raw garlic. Garlic preparations vary in chemistry, and the air-dried garlic we use contains very little of the oxidative component that may cause problems if used in excess, so it is gentle and absolutely safe for everyday, year-round use. We feel you may feed our garlic with complete confidence.

Garlic for pregnant, nursing, and newborn animals:

Many of garlic's nutritional and protective properties are passed on from the mother to the baby during gestation. The customers who have had the best experiences with nursing animals and garlic have introduced it very slowly, taking at least 10 days to ensure acceptance. Foals or puppies can be fed garlic as soon as they are weaned. Many breeders report great results with this.

Increasing garlic with the change of seasons:

Off Garlic year-round, and double or triple the dosage in the spring and the fall. Most people are aware that spring can be very buggy, but it's less well known that fall is a concern, too. Insects like ticks surge in the fall, desperately looking for a last blood meal to survive the winter. We recommend feeding Bug Off Garlic daily, year-round, because it can be challenging to re-introduce Bug Off Garlic after a hiatus, particularly with picky animals.



Garlic for animals other than dogs and horses:

Our customers have used garlic successfully on miniature horses, donkeys, goats, sheep, rabbits, alpacas, llamas, deer, and cats as well as many other farm animals. You can calculate the correct dose by body weight according to the dog recommendations for smaller animals or the horse recommendations for the larger animals.

Garlic as a dewormer or heartworm preventative:

Although **Bug Off Garlic** is helpful in reducing both internal and external parasites, you may wish to consult your practitioner for these issues. For a list of holistic veterinarians in your area, you can visit the American Holistic Veterinary Medical Association online (http://www.ahvma.org/).

Garlic for picky or finicky eaters:

For dogs, starting off slowly is key. In addition, adding a tasty treat, such as a little peanut butter, liverwurst, cottage cheese, yogurt or canned dog food, is also helpful. For horses, start off VERY slowly, sprinkling a teaspoon or less on the feed (using a spray bottle filled with water if necessary) and sprinkling the garlic around the feed area on the ground. When the horse begins to accept the aroma of the feed, it is safe to increase the dosage slowly.

Garlic granules with dry food:

Customers who feed grain, pelleted feed, or kibble have developed various strategies to prevent garlic granules from falling to the bottom of the bucket or bowl. For horses, customers have often reported using a spray bottle filled with water to lightly coat the feed before sprinkling the garlic on with great success. For dogs, mixing the granules with a little bit of a favorite canned dog food or a wet treat, such as plain yogurt, liverwurst, or peanut butter, often helps.


