



As we not so patiently await the arrival of beach season, get ready for the summer by grabbing your local beach season badge and familiarize yourself with all that your beach has to offer. Whether you head to a beach in Monmouth or Ocean county on just the weekends or you sunbathe daily all summer long, the wait is almost over for a summer full of long and lazy days at the beach soaking up the sun and cooling off in the salt water.

#### **ASBURY PARK**

Daily badge weekday: \$5

Daily badge weekend and holiday: \$7
Season badge adult: \$70
Season badge teens and seniors: \$20
A mile of beach and surf with the Asbury
Park Convention Hall and The Casino building as bookends. Enjoy boutiques, fun and food for all ages. Pay station street parking is available.

#### **AVON-BY-THE-SEA**

Daily badge 12 and over: \$9 Season badge adult: \$90

Season badge teens and seniors: \$45
Restrooms are located on the boardwalk at
Lincoln and Norwood avenues. Restaurants
located on or near the boardwalk, which
make great stops for lunch, dinner or
drinks after a long day in the sun. Parking
is free.

#### BELMAR

Daily badge: \$9; free for 15 and under Season badge adult: \$70 Season badge seniors: \$30 Food and concession stands are located along the boardwalk. There are colorful and fun beach playgrounds every few blocks and several beaches are devoted to activities like boogie boarding, kayaking and surfing. Several beaches are also

equipped with poles for volleyball nets.

#### **BRADLEY BEACH**

Daily badge: \$9; free for 12 and under Season badge adult: \$75

Season badge seniors: \$30

Season badge juniors ages 13-15: \$25 Public restrooms are located at Newark, LaReine. Third and Evergreen avenues. Showers are located at each beach entrance. Changing rooms are located at Cliff and Third avenues. Surfing is allowed at Third Avenue Beach. Fishing is allowed on beach jetties at Lake Terrace. Park Place and Brinley and Second avenues at the discretion of lifeguards. Beach is accessible for those who use wheelchairs at Newark. **Brinley, Third and Evergreen avenues. Park**ing pay stations are \$1.50 per hour and accept cash, credit or debit cards. Parking is free on the west side of Ocean Avenue. The beachfront has food concessions at Cliff, LaReine, and Second avenues. There is a toddler park for children ages 1-4 located on Park Place Avenue.

#### LONG BRANCH

Daily badge weekdays: \$5
Daily badge weekends and holidays: \$7;
\$3 for ages 14-17; under age 13 are
always free

Season badge adults 18-61: \$45; 65 and

Season badge students 14-17: \$30; 13 and under free

Restrooms and shower towers are located at West End Avenue, Cottage Place, N Bath Avenue, Great Lawn Beach, Laird Street Beach, Seaview Avenue, Chelsea Avenue and Morris Avenue Beach. There are also shower towers located at Brighton Avenue, S. Bath Avenue and Pavilion Avenue. On the boardwalk Pier Village offers restaurants and shops.

#### **MANASQUAN**

Daily badge: \$9

Season badge adult: \$80 Season badge ages 12-16: \$35

The Manasquan beach and boardwalk are home to several eateries, shops and an arcade, as well as several restroom facilities for beachgoers.

#### **MONMOUTH BEACH**

Daily badge: \$9 Season badge: \$75

Restrooms and enclosed showers are available at 29 Ocean Ave. There is also a snack bar at the pavilion.

#### **OCEAN GROVE**

Daily badge: \$9

Season badge adult: \$90

Season badge ages 12-17 and seniors 65 and over: \$45

Parking on the street is free. Beach concessions located on the beach as well as beach chair and umbrella rentals.

#### **SANDY HOOK**

Daily parking: \$15 per car Seasonal parking: \$75 Beaches and parks on Sandy Hook are free

Portable restrooms are available at all beach areas, but there is limited availability of showers and changing rooms. There is an upcharge for oversized vehicles: daily \$30; seasonal \$150. Enjoy free concerts on the beach every Wednesday evening at 6 p.m.at Beach Area E from June through August.

#### **SEA GIRT**

Daily badge: \$10

Season badge adult: \$105

Season badge seniors ages 65 and up: \$60
Restrooms are located at the pavilion on Beacon
Boulevard. Lockers are available for \$18 per day.
Parking is free for all beachgoers. Head up to the
boardwalk and check out the panoramic view of
the Atlantic Ocean, which begins at the historic
Sea Girt Lighthouse.

## SEVEN PRESIDENTS OCEAN FRONT PARK, LONG BRANCH

Daily badge 18 and over: \$8

Season badge adult: \$70

Season badge seniors ages 65 and up: \$25 Daily parking passes are \$10; season parking is \$70. A snack bar, covered eating area and outdoor showers are available to beach patrons, as is a beach volleyball court. Skateplex skateboard park and Tony's Place are also open.

#### **SPRING LAKE**

Daily badge ages 12 and up: \$10 Season badge adult: \$105; Late season badge [after August 1]: \$65

Season badge seniors: \$75

Restrooms are available at Pier Beach, the North End Pavilion and the South End Pavilion. The two-mile boardwalk offers snack bars at the pavilions. Each pavilion also features a saltwater pool.

#### **UNION BEACH**

Entrance to the bay beach is free and parking is available. The bay beach is a unique area along the Raritan Bay that stretches about 1.9 square miles. The beach is handicapped accessible.

#### **BRICK TOWNSHIP BEACHES 1 & 3**

Daily badge: \$5

Preseason before June 15: \$25

Season badges: \$30

Ages 12 and under are free.

Both beaches have restrooms and snack concessions, along with showers and lockers. Daily parking is \$5 per car. Additional parking across the street.

## ISLAND BEACH STATE PARK SEASIDE PARK

You are required to pay a per-car entry fee when you enter Island Beach State Park.

Weekdays for NJ residents: \$6; nonresidents \$12.

Weekends and holidays for NJ residents: \$10; nonresidents \$20.

Motorcycles for NJ residents: \$5; nonresidents \$7. Swimming and surf fishing are the two most popular recreational activities.

# BIERGARTEN, BOARDWALK GAMES AND BASEBALL ARE BACK AT

Last season the BlueClaws stadium added a new Biergarten, mini-golf, boardwalk games and an added night of fireworks. This season BlueClaws brings it all back with a few more new additions for fans to rejoice over.

### THE BIERGARTEN AND SUMMER CONCERT SERIES

"So we have the Biergarten and it's been really popular last summer, that was our debut," shared Greg Giombarrese, director of communications for the Lakewood BlueClaws.

Every week Thirsty Thursday will continue to take place in the Biergarten with \$1 Coors and Coors light drafts along with wing specials from

Quaker Steak and Lube.

"So that's every Thursday and those are really good," said Giombarrese. "Fridays this year we added in Fiesta Fridays so we do nachos, BlueClaws bowls and some other food and drink specials. That's every Friday.

"Then Saturdays, starting in June, will be the Summer Concert Series. Just as we did last year, we'll have bands each week and they will be out there"

Some of the Summer Concert Series' most popular performing acts will be back for another season.

"... Last year we had Splintered Sunlight and they'll be back on June 22," he added. "They're a Grateful Dead Tribute band and that was immensely popular. We weren't really sure how that was going to go, but it turned out to be really tremendous so that was great."

Country band After the Reign will also return as well as the Parrot Beach Band, which is a Jimmy Buffet-style tribute band. Asbury Fever will perform on July 27 for Bruce Springsteen night. On Aug. 10, The Snakes will perform for Irish Heritage Night.

"The Snakes have been coming out here for a few years and then the schedules kind of didn't work and we're happy to get them back," said Giombarrese. "They're really popular. It's a good program."

According to Giombarrese, this year the gates will open at 6 p.m. instead of 5 p.m. and the bands will start at 6:30 p.m. in the Biergarten and play into the game. "So you'll have a lot of fans hang out in the berm over there," he said.

The TVs in the Biergarten will show the game as well so fans don't have to worry about missing a thing and they can enjoy drink specials and everything from the comfort of the Biergarten.

"Founders Brewing is the corporate partner on that so they'll provide a lot of drink specials for those too," added Giombarrese. "So it's a good program and it's been popular over the years. I'm looking forward to bringing it back for 2019."

In an effort to expand the music offerings, there will be live entertainment every Thursday, Friday and Saturday night in the Biergarten. While the actual band will perform on Saturday, there will be some kind of acoustic performance on Thursdays and Fridays to provide some background noise to the Biergarten.

#### FIREWORKS FRENZY

"... So then fireworks will follow those Saturday games too," added Giombarrese. "Last year we added fireworks on Saturdays. This year we have them on Thursdays too and we've always had them on Friday. So we'll go Thursday, Friday and Saturday now."

That means 26 fireworks displays for the year. Since the season is already underway, three of those shows have already dazzled the night sky. Fans can still look forward to 23 fireworks shows at the stadium for the rest of the season.

"Basically it's after every Thursday, Friday, Saturday game plus July 3," he said. "So we're excited about that. Everybody loves the fireworks and they put on a good show out here.

"So that will be what we're looking forward to, we're looking forward to that a lot," he added.

The addition of the Biergarten last year led to the opportunity to add another night of fireworks this year. Giombarrese explained that since they did Thirsty Thursday out in center field, they couldn't really do a fireworks show that day. Now that Thirsty Thursday takes place in the Biergarten on the left field side, fireworks can shoot off from center field. Postgame fireworks will start in June.

In addition to the added fireworks, the Biergarten remains as something well embraced by the BlueClaws' fans.

"People seem to like it," he said."There's plenty of room out there. They have the heaters. They have the lights. A variety of options. You have the stage facing out. They kind of played around and did some things to improve the sound system out there as well.

"They had the TV so we have the game on there and then if you want to watch on the berm over there on the side,

you can easily do that. You're right next to the Biergarten anyway. You can watch on the berm, you can still hear the music and you can watch the game so you know you have a little something for everybody there."

#### **NEW ADDITIONS**

The picnic areas are another part of the park that got revamped this season. "... They put in a lot of brand new seating and redesigned the whole picnic areas, two of them, so there's one on first base side and one on third base side," said Giombarrese. "All of the seats will now face the field

"We used to have square tables so you'd have some people facing backwards and some people facing, but now

everything faces the field. They have high top seating on some spots, some standard seating. There's a lot more room for people to walk around and then they upgraded the menus for those as well, too.

"Yeah, that was the big improvement for this year. Last year they did the mini-golf and the boardwalk games."

The boardwalk games and mini-golf will also remain for this year's season after last year's debut. With every season's new additions, BlueClaws continually strives to be a place that offers something for everyone to enjoy.

"That was the goal," he responded. "So you have the mini-golf for the younger kids and then the boardwalk games are kind of a little older and pretty much anybody could do that, but it's really for kids.


"The sweet spot there's like ... kids between 7 and 18. And then the adults obviously in the Biergarten 21 and over. It works out ,you know, as something for everybody. Not only that, you get to use the whole concourse."

Prior to the addition of the Biergarten, the 360 degrees of the facility wasn't properly utilized. According to Giombarrese, when Thirsty Thursday was held in center field there was nothing connecting the seats behind home plate and out there

"But now you have like Major Ballpark Fun Zones," he added. "And all corners of the stadium, which is really exciting. People have really responded well to it. So it's been really good."

And while the Summer Concert Series started out as just a few special nights of music, over the past few years, they have really formalized the night and formed the Summer Concert Series as it is today.

"And you know, you're kind of at the mercy of our schedule, but we're able to make it work so I'm looking forward to getting those going in the summer," shared Giombarrese.







## Dining at DUKE'S

Sam Chiarella is no stranger to the restaurant industry or the area as he first opened Fratello's in Sea Girt in 1997, which he sold in '06, followed by the opening of Rella's in Brielle in 2009, which he sold last summer. In 2017 he opened Duke's, originally as a barbecue concept in Point Pleasant Beach, and now Duke's is gearing up for another summer with a more tavernstyle menu and atmosphere.

#### **DUKE'S TAVERN & TAP**

"It went from Duke's Supper & Spirits, which was barbecue, to Duke's Tavern & Tap," said Chiarella. "And that's basically what we are, we're a tavern and we pride ourselves on being food-driven. Food is always good and fresh for tavern fare."

Duke's serves the same pizza that Chiarella cranked out for nine years at Rella's and was

very popular.

"We have entertainment on weekends, Fridays and Saturdays," he said. "We keep our kitchen open later starting Memorial Day, we keep it open until midnight. So we do a happy hour from 2 to 6 p.m. and then we do it again from 10 p.m. to 12 a.m."

The change from the initial barbecue concept ultimately stemmed from it being a poor fit in the area with a lack of interest on the part of clientele.

"You know what it was with the barbecue, it's not even that we didn't execute, it's just that the interest in barbecue just wasn't that big and I think people when they really want barbecue are going to just go to a little BYOB place," explained Chiarella.

"And I think it's a lot to do with being near the water," he added. "They want seafood. But, yeah, we wanted to make it — there's so many seafood places where you can get fresh seafood that we want to have seafood, but we also want to have something else too."

Getting off to a slow start during the summer 2017 opening, has not slowed Chiarella down. He admits that last summer a lot of people still didn't really know

that Duke's changed concepts, but this summer he's hopeful that everyone is now aware.

"So I think this is the first summer that people are really going to know me and know my history a little bit and I think this summer will be a really good summer in terms of people finally identifying with what Duke's really is as opposed to a barbecue place," expressed Chiarella.

"It's not barbecue. So I think a lot of people still don't know that, but the majority of people in the area are starting to understand that, which is exciting. It makes me optimistic for the summer."

#### **MUCH MORE TO THE MEN**U

In addition to the full dining room and bar, Duke's Tavern & Tap is also home to a small upstairs deck for outdoor dining. According to Chiarella, it's a good spot for fireworks on Thursday nights once they start for the summer.

The restaurant offers dining specials each day of the week. Monday is Lobster Night starting on Memorial Day, Tuesday is Half-Price Apps all day and night, Wednesday is Game Night, which is trivia and Name that Tune, which is complemented by 2-for-1 bar pies and finally Thursday is Prime Rib Night.

Beginning the first week of June, Duke's

will be open daily for lunch and dinner opening at 11:30 a.m. In addition to the special nights, the restaurant will also feature nightly dinner specials.

"For the summer we'll have a bunch of seafood specials," shared Chiarella.

Can't miss menu items? The pizza, of course, not to mention the burgers too.

"I think the pizza is growing in popularity," said Chiarella. "We sell a lot of burgers too."

"But I think pizza is something we sort of made a name for ourselves in Brielle and that sort of transferred here as well. But then we have steaks, we have fresh seafood, a couple pasta dishes, pizza, we have a burger section, we have a lot of apps. So the menu's pretty diverse."

#### STOP INTO DUKE'S THIS SUMMER

Chiarella's track record of successful eateries from Fratello's to Rella's to Duke's quite simply speaks for itself. While Rella's has come and gone, its pizza remains and those who don't want to dine out can enjoy the pizza for take out as well. The entire menu will likely be available this summer on Doordash.

"We're just a good local spot ... if they want to come out and grab a drink and grab a good bite to eat, this is the place to be," said Chiarella.







Schwartz shared that one of the difficulties iPlay America faces as a business is to be able to set an adult vibe because when people hear iPlay America they often think kids.

"So being able to really build this Top Golf Swing Suite brand is going to not only elevate the adult experience, but is also going to elevate the restaurant," said Schwartz.

The restaurant she referenced is Game Time Bar & Grill at iPlay America. The hope is that people will begin to think of it more as a place for people to come and eat and play as opposed to people just thinking it's a kids place and a restaurant inside iPlay America.

According to Schwartz, she feels the benefit of iPlay is also the fact that if you do want that experience you can get that as well. No matter the age, she admits that the birthday party goers love laser tag, playing skeeball and more.

"I guess you're only as old as you think you are," she said, adding that she's had birthday parties for 70-year-olds in the amusement park at iPlay America.

"So I think that's the nice part about it, like our

adult parties you can incorporate Top Golf for an hour and it's a package and you also get a park package with it as well and there's four different packages that you can choose from," said Schwartz. "So there's a food package, a park package and then you can choose to add Top Golf. The gaming package includes unlimited pool, unlimited non-redemption video games, all of those types of things."

There is also another bar that is not too far from the Top Golf space so if the bar is really crazy patrons can walk down to the other or vice yersa.

The Top Golf and bar areas are also quite separate from the amusement park area, where all the kids are, which makes the over 21 feel in certain areas easier to attain.

Another positive for the Top Golf Swing Suite and iPlay America as a whole is a lack of weather

dependency. You won't ever have to worry about a party being cancelled because of rain since everything the business has to offer is indoors.

"And you get the outdoor feel indoors," shared Schwartz. "If you're going to go into the park, it has a feeling like you're outdoors, but you're indoors. We say 'the Jersey Shore Indoors,' that's kind of how we are.

"And same thing here [Top Golf area]. It's not dependent on weather for the party giver. Sometimes our business gets a little dependent on weather, unfortunately, but it's really great."

In the Top Golf Swing Suite there are six unique bays with game simulators including golf, hockey, dodgeball, baseball and football. There is also lounge seating, full food and beverage service and much more.

You can reserve a bay for up to eight people on your own. Parties of up to 44 people can be booked through their Top Golf Swing Suite Reservation Specialist and over 50 people goes up to the Corporate Sales Department.

In addition, Schwartz shared they will offer full rentals for company outings, corporate team building or whatever the company wishes to do. It's a four-hour time slot available Monday through Friday during the day and then Monday through Thursday at night. You can also add Top Golf to any adult party, which is the most economical way to experience TopGolf with a large group, according to Schwartz.

TopGolf can also be added to any of the team building packages in the park.

"I think I'm looking forward to having something to really elevate our brand," said Schwartz in response to what she's most looking forward to with the addition of TopGolf.

### **BLOCK PARTY 21 AND OVER**

Every Friday night iPlay America holds a Block Party, which is for those 21 and over. This is another avenue they really want to build, shared Schwartz.

"We've struggled a little bit in building that night," explained Schwartz. "I think because we didn't have something like this [Top Golf] to offer people, but now that we do to bring that more over here.

"We have a live DJ every Friday night. We do a country version once a month where we have Thunder 106 come out and there's a country DJ playing country music and stuff like that,

Line Dancing in City Square.

"But the Friday night is when you're going to get that all-adult-only experience that you know that there's going to be no kids allowed, she added. "And I think that's going to be really advantageous to a lot of people's experience."

### **GAME TIME BAR & GRILL**

Game Time Bar & Grill welcomed a new executive chef, Adam Livow, to its team and he is really revamping the entire Game Time menu.

"Everything is prepared from scratch in house," shared Schwartz. "I mean, the mac and cheese bites, he's literally making the mac and cheese. Everything is freshly prepared.

While doing everything from scratch is more cost

effective it is also much more time consuming, but Livow doesn't mind.


"So you need someone who's dedicated and really wants to do that," she added. "And Adam is top notch with that and he is creative."
