

create your own tea towel lady!

a great way to merchandise and inspire sales



- here's how -

materials

- purchase our tea towel lady bundle (available for Spring or Fall)
- a full size ladies mannequin (call us if you need a resource)
- 30+ T-pins

instructions



STEP 1. Starting with the bodice, wrap a tea towel lengthwise just above the bust, securing pins at the top on either side. Do the same on the back side of the bodice, and secure the tea towel down so it lays smooth against the mannequin.



STEP 2. To make the skirt, pinch the tea towel from the middle and let the fabric fall into a triangle shape. Pin the pinched center to the mannequin just below the waistline. Repeat this step all the way around the mannequin to create a full skirt.



STEP 3. Next you will need to create the straps. Lay a tea towel down with the back side up, and begin rolling from one corner. Roll until you have a long rectangle. Place the tea towel over the shoulder and pin on either side. This should look like a shoulder strap to a dress. Repeat this process for the second strap and secure both the front and back with t-pins. The final step is to create the waist belt, which will cover the pins from the skirt and the ends of each of your shoulder straps. Repeat the same rolling process to create the waist belt, and wrap it around the waistline to cover the strap ends and skirt pins.

Pin securely in the back and enjoy your new Tea Towel Lady!
