

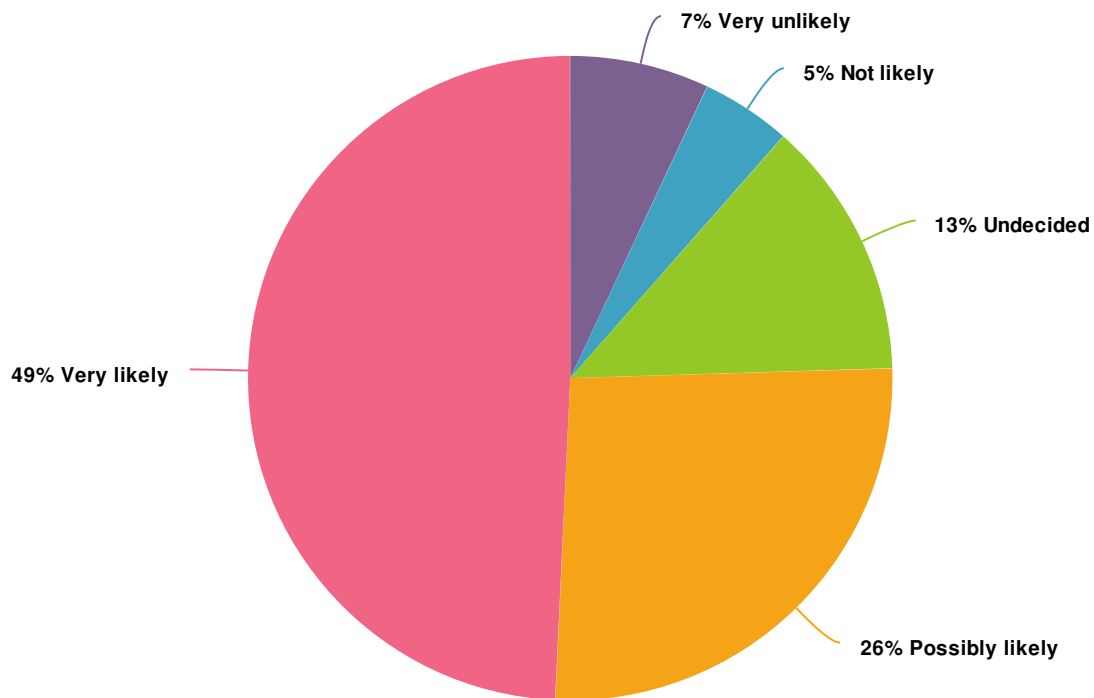

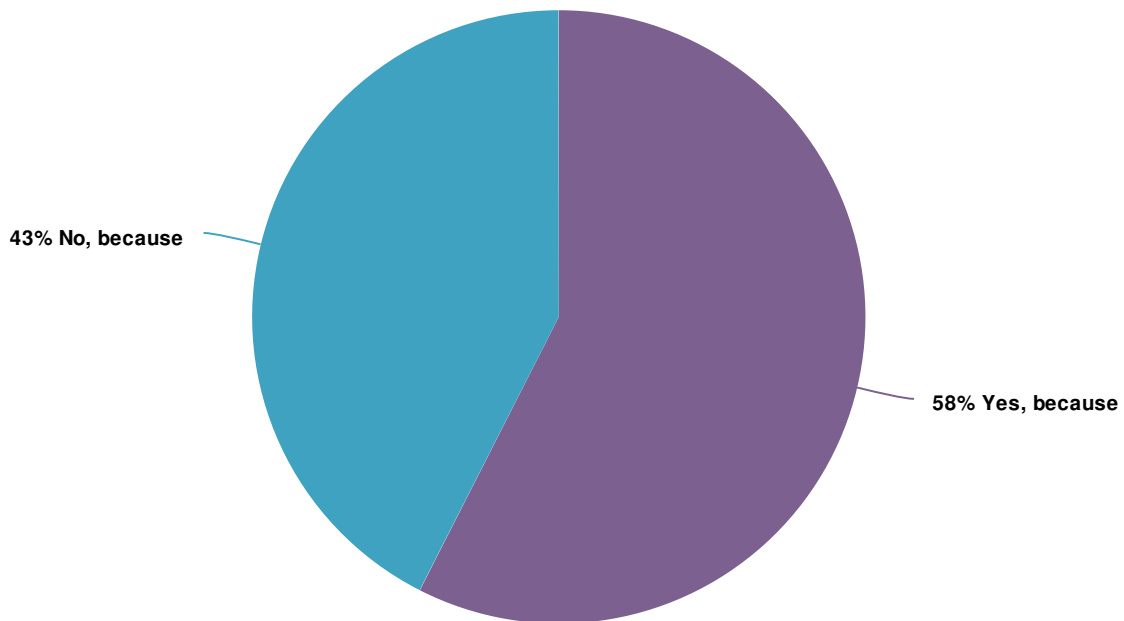

1. How likely is it that would you participate in a clinical research study?



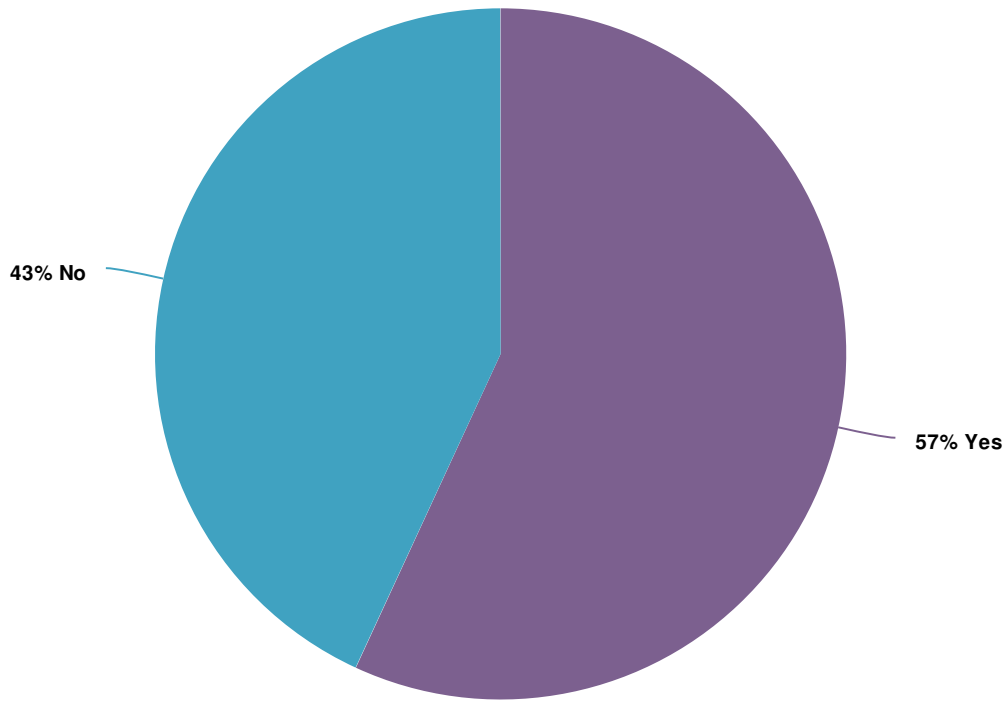

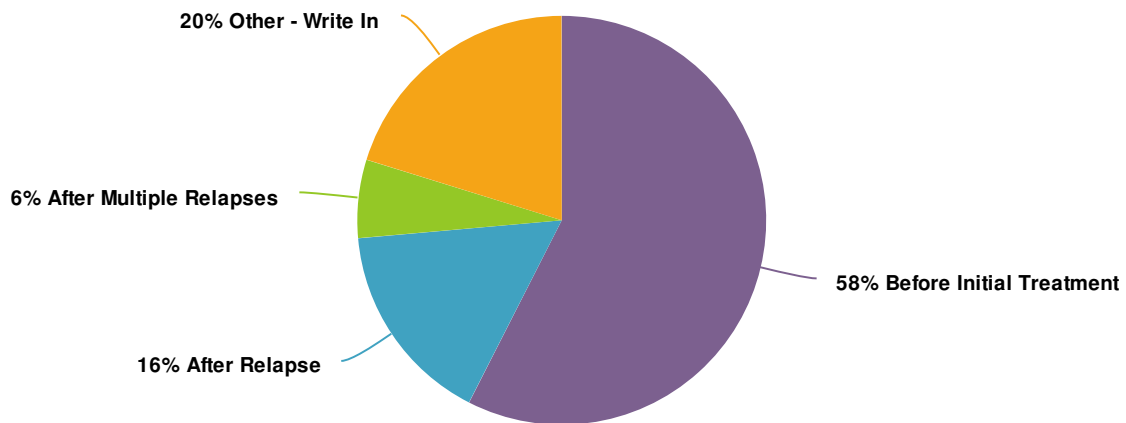
3. At anytime, during your care, did your medical team discuss participating in a clinical trial?

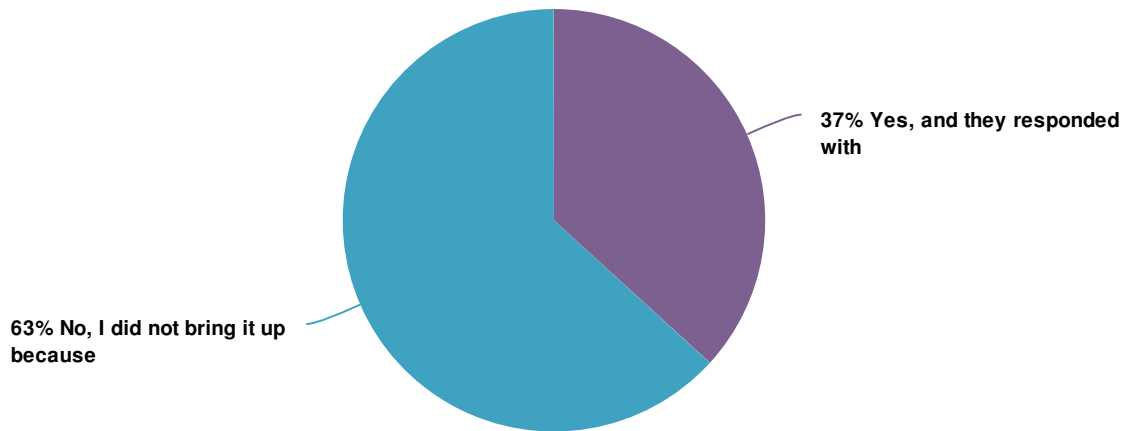
4. If Yes, was it discussed before your first cancer treatment, cancer retreatment, or both?

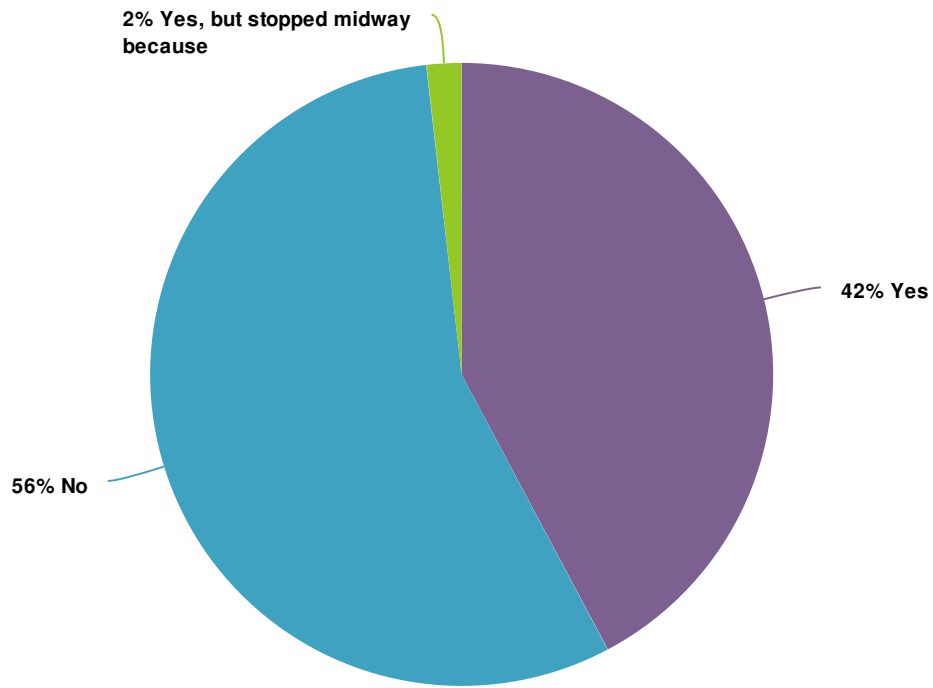

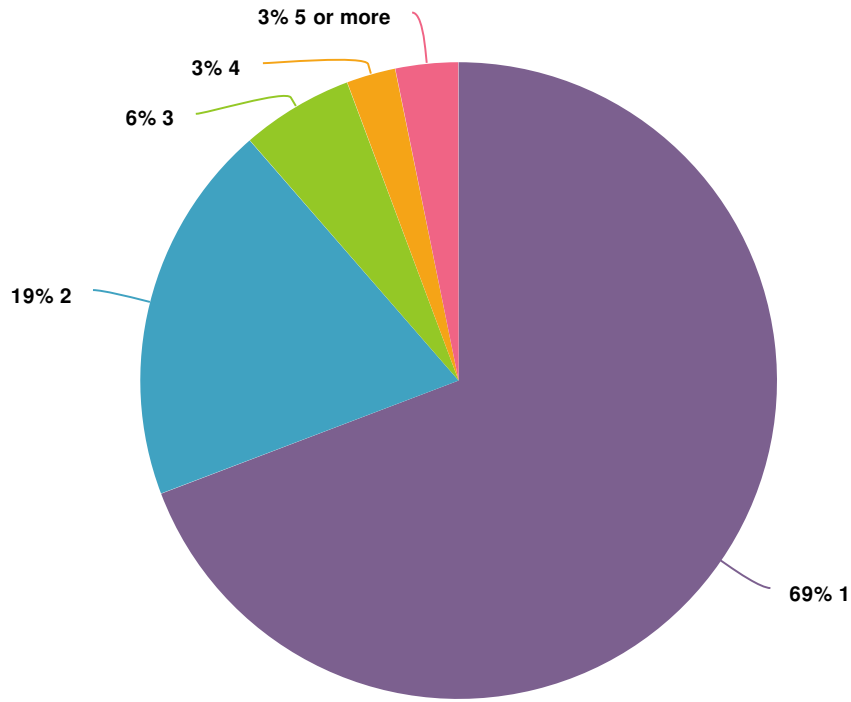
6. Have you participated in a clinical research study for your cancer?

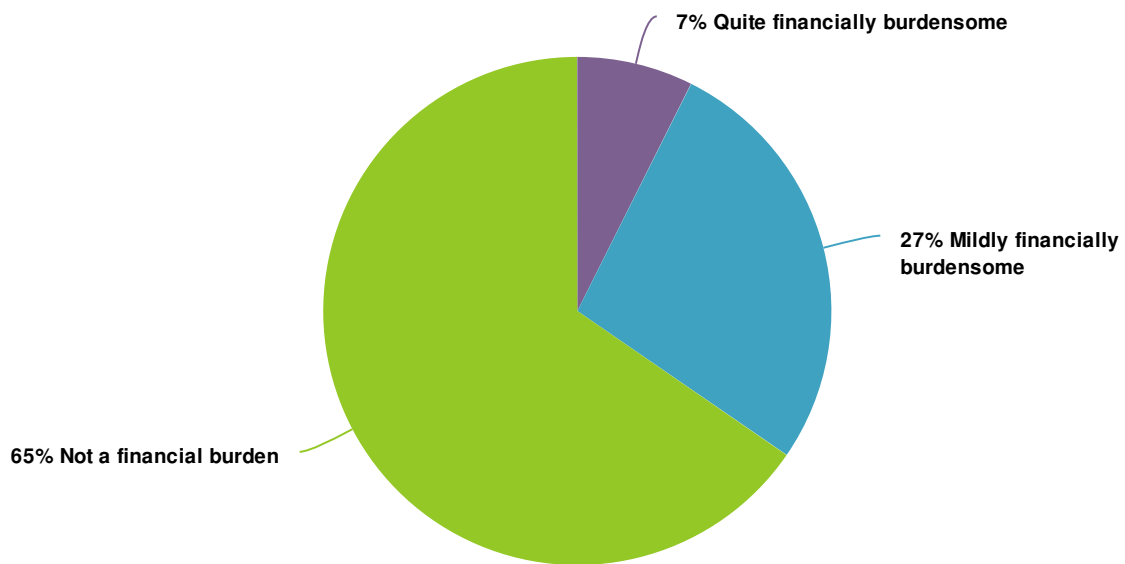
7. If yes, how many studies?

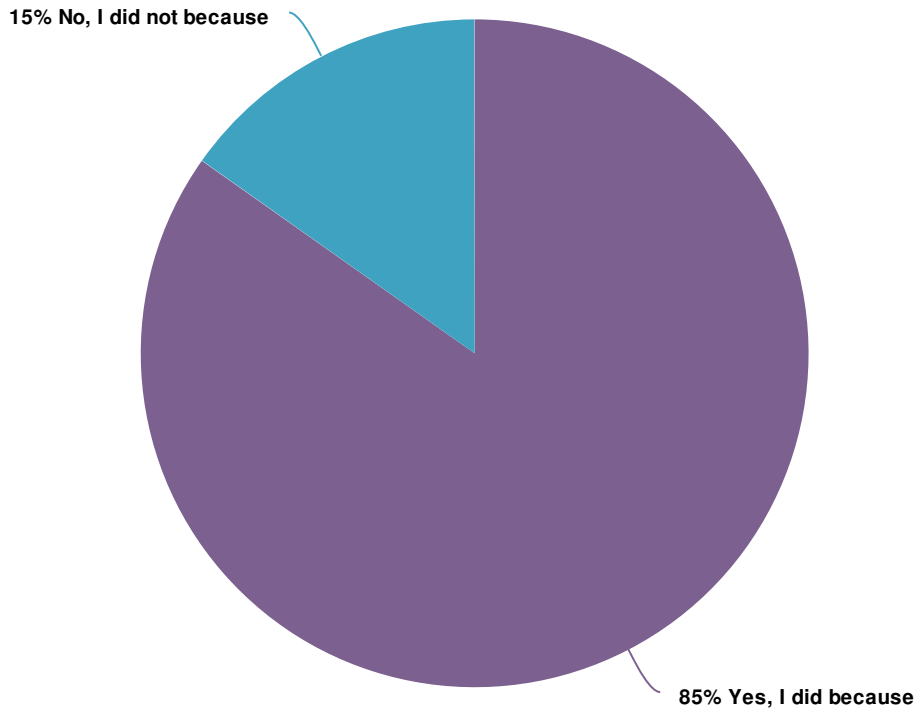

8. If Yes, how financially burdensome was it for you to participate in the clinical study/studies?



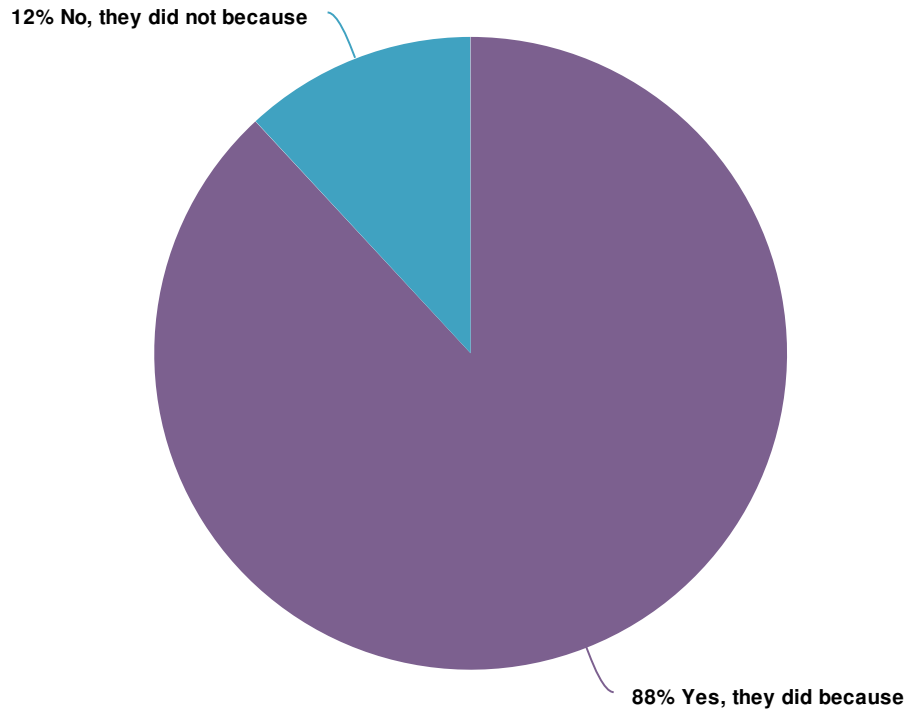

9. If Yes, do you believe you derived clinical benefit from participating in the study/studies?



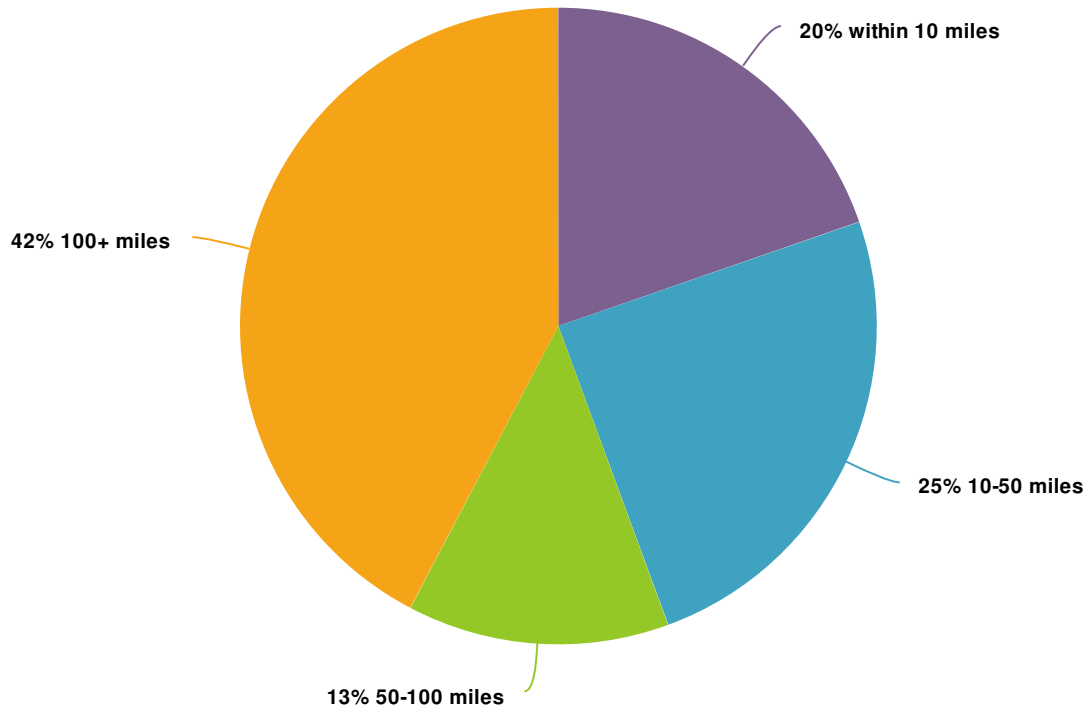

10. If Yes, did your treating physician believe you derived clinical benefit from participating in the study/studies?



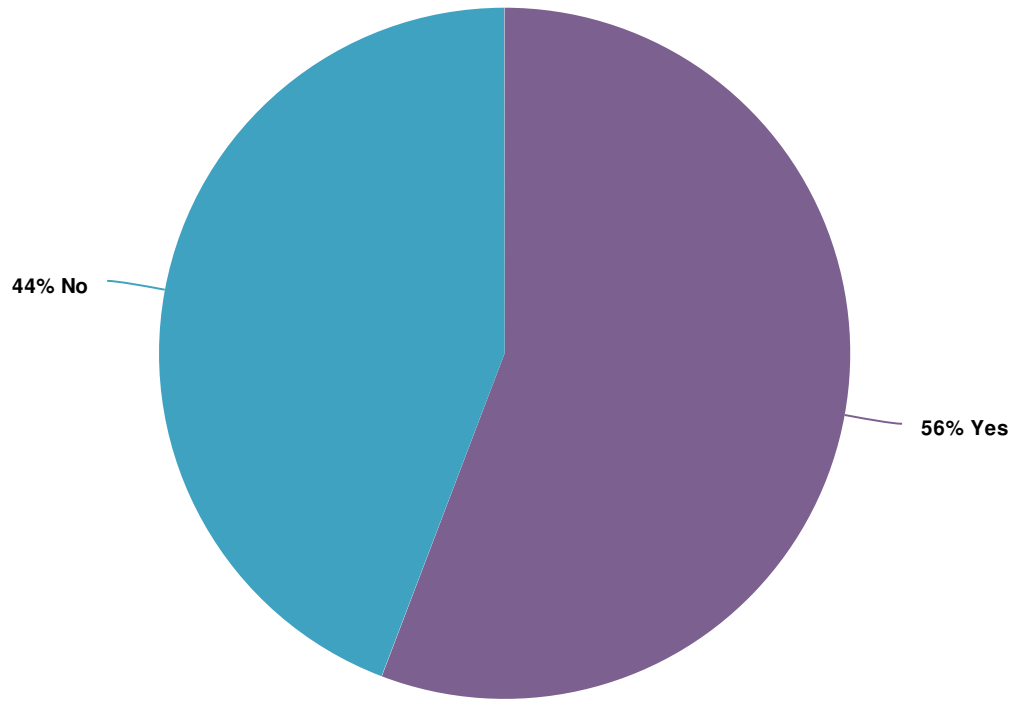

11. If Yes, how far from your home to the clinical trial site did you have to travel?



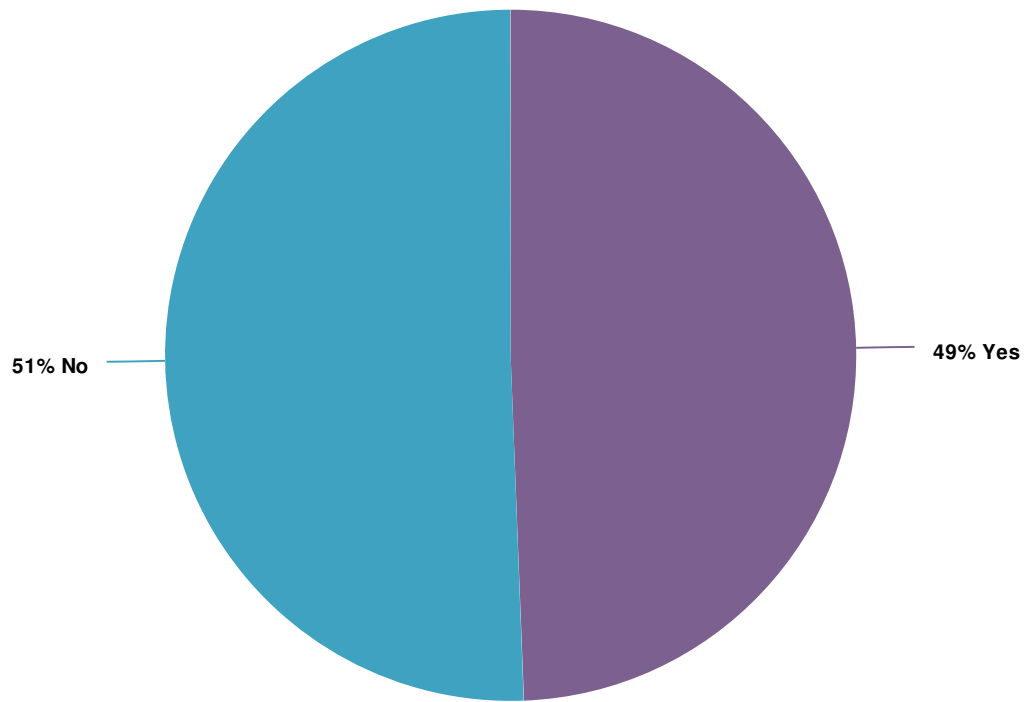

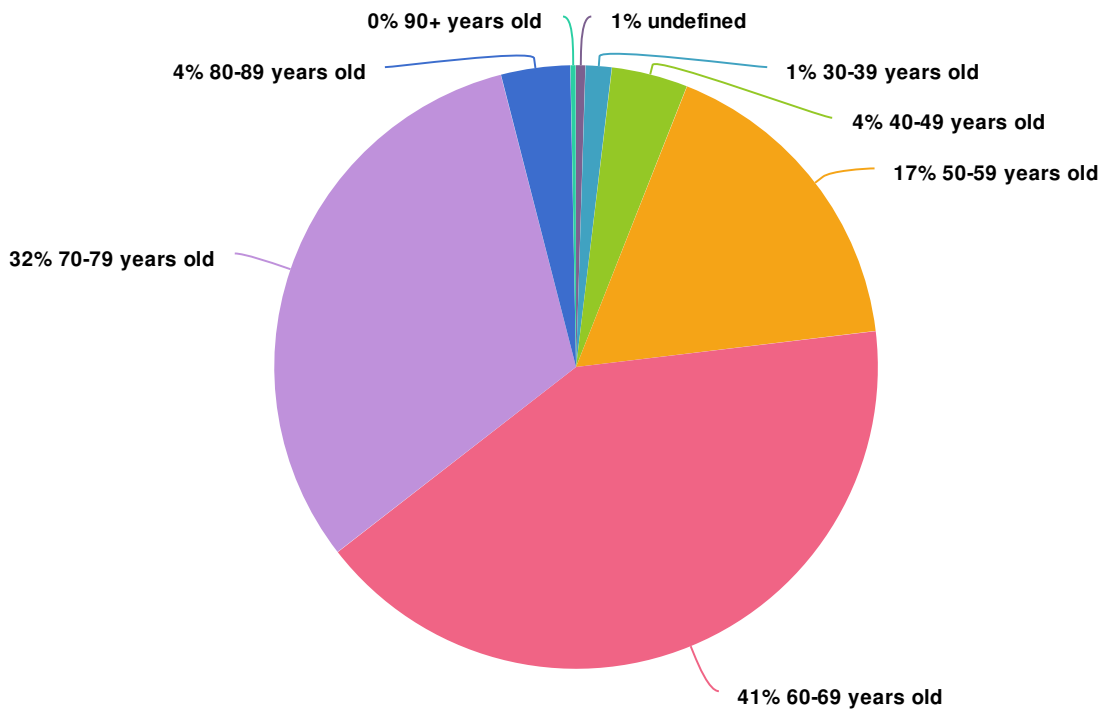
