PREPARATION FOR WORSHIP:

The trinity symbol is, along with the Celtic Knot, one of the most famous symbols from the Celtic heritage. The trinity symbol, or the Triquetra can be described as an individual strand that wraps into and onto itself and looks like a three-sided, three-lobed yet singular design. It is believed that this symbol was adopted by Celtic culture from Germanic, as the word 'triquetra' itself is derived from the Latin words *tri-* meaning three and *quetrus-* meaning corners.
