## What is the working environment like?

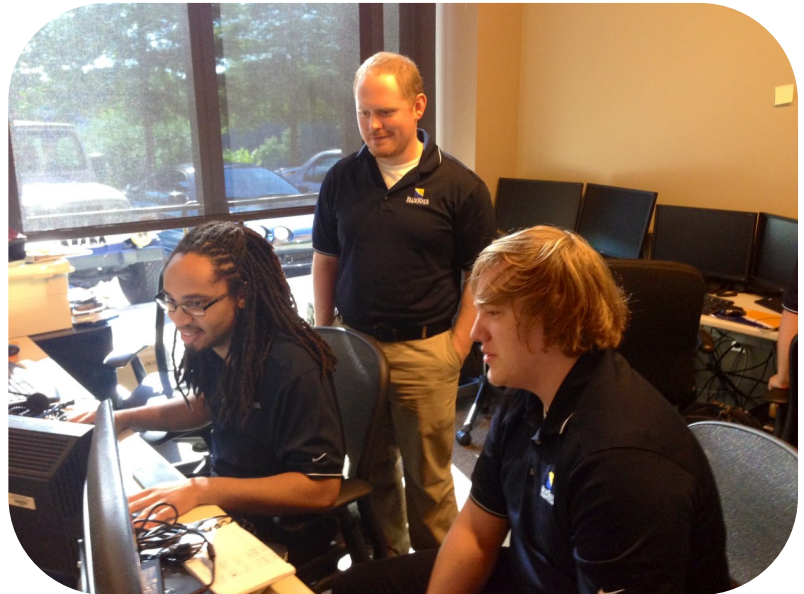
"Fun! We have a lot of fun at work while getting what needs to be done finished in a timely manner."
