DAIRY SCHOLARSHIP GRANT OVERVIEW

Applications are due December 6.

Today's evolving dairy industry faces complex challenges that require strong resourceful leadership today and tomorrow. The Central Plains Dairy Foundation has funding available through the CPDF Dairy Scholarships grant program to support the future of dairy through dairy student scholarships.

ELIGIBILITY

Applicant schools should be two or four year colleges or universities that offer one or more dairy education programs. Schools must be located in the Central Plains Dairy Association membership states of Iowa, Minnesota, Nebraska, South Dakota or North Dakota to be eligible. Grants must be used for scholarship awards to dairy students.

SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES

While the Central Plains Dairy Foundation acknowledges that scholarship recipients will be selected by the participating colleges or universities, the Board of Directors asks that scholarships are awarded based on contributions to and involvement in the dairy industry, demonstrated leadership, initiative and integrity, commitment to a career in a dairy-related discipline and academic standing.

REQUIREMENTS

1. Applications are due by December 6, 2019. Scholarship grant awards will be announced by the end of December 2019.
2. A detailed report of the scholarships awarded must be submitted to the Foundation by June 30.
