

SHARING THE GOSPEL WITH KIDS

PREPARATION

- **BIBLE:** have each participant bring their Bible
- **PEN**
- **STICKY NOTES:** each participant needs about 5 sticky notes or tabs
- **HANDOUT:** [a copy for each participant](#)
- **THE GOSPEL GOD'S PLAN FOR ME:** [resource available on LifeWay.com](#)

LEADER

Say: We ask that you lean in, take part in our activities, and pray that God will teach us all something about communicating the gospel more clearly with the kids. During this next video, we are going to pass a few sticky note pads down the aisles. Please grab one sticky note as the pad passes by. You'll also need your Bible during this training session. Take a handout and you'll see several blanks to fill in during today's training.

LEADER

Say: Our goal today is to learn how to clearly share the gospel with kids. Did you get to fill in those two blanks? (Kids are important to Jesus. And God's will is for kids to be saved and have a relationship with Him.)

This training and activities will use a specific method of sharing the Gospel. It's called "The Gospel: God's Plan for Me." Let's break down what this method looks like.

[\[VIDEO 2: THE GOSPEL: GOD'S PLAN FOR ME\]](#)

LEADER

Say: We love how this plan shares the whole truth of the gospel on a kid's level. Always have your physical Bibles open to certain passages when you share the gospel. Go ahead and pull out your Bible, your handout, the sticky notes, and a pen. I'd love to show you how to tab your Bible to easily find key passages in God's Word when you share with kids. (*hold up your TABBED Bible - you may need to tab some things for example*)

TRAINING SESSION BY



(walk them through cutting or ripping off a piece of a sticky note and tabbing their Bibles on the following passages)

- GOD RULES - Genesis 1:1
- WE SINNED - Romans 3:23
- GOD PROVIDED - Ephesians 2:8-9
- JESUS GIVES - Romans 5:8
- WE RESPOND - Romans 10:9-10

Now that we've tabbed our Bibles, let's check out some other practical tips for sharing the gospel and talking with kids.

[VIDEO 3: PRACTICAL TIPS FOR SHARING THE GOSPEL WITH KIDS]

LEADER

Say: Let's focus on that one tip that says "Tell Your Story." We always need to tell our stories in kid-appropriate ways and always share the gospel when we tell our story. We're now going to take about 6 minutes and practice sharing our stories briefly, and incorporating the gospel into our stories. I'd love for you all to group up in groups of 3-4 and briefly share your story how you would share it to a kid. We may not get to everyone, but that's okay. I'll let you know when to return to your seats.

[6 minute timer on the screen if possible]

LEADER

Say: Great job. I want to encourage you to share your story of how you met Jesus and be sure to include the gospel in it when you talk with kids here at church and at home. A kid's relationship with Jesus doesn't end when they make a decision to follow him, there's SO much more than that. Let's check out this last video and unpack that.

[VIDEO 4: WHAT'S NEXT?]

LEADER

Say: You're going to have the opportunity to have conversations with kids that will carry on for years and point them back to Jesus throughout their entire lives. Let's close out today with a time of prayer for you as you minister to and talk with kids.

PRAY / DISMISS

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
