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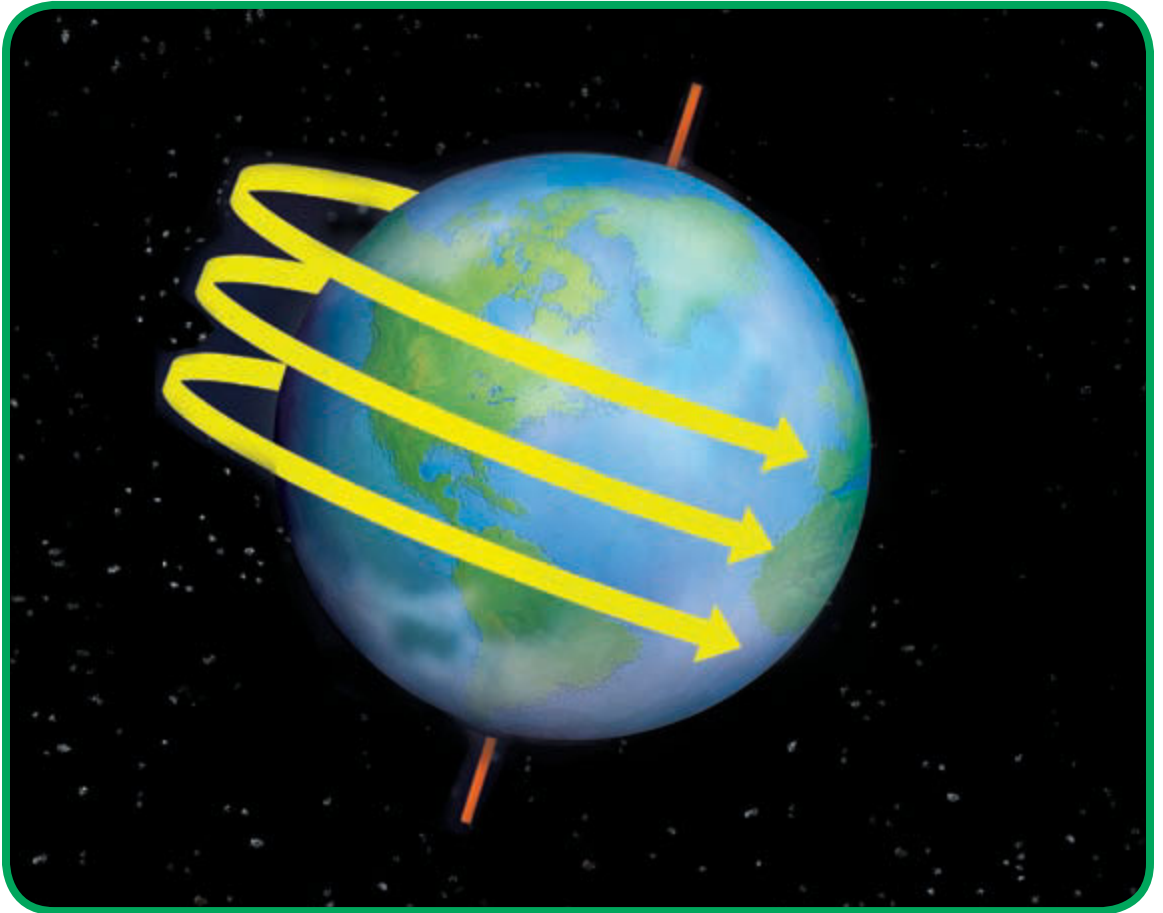
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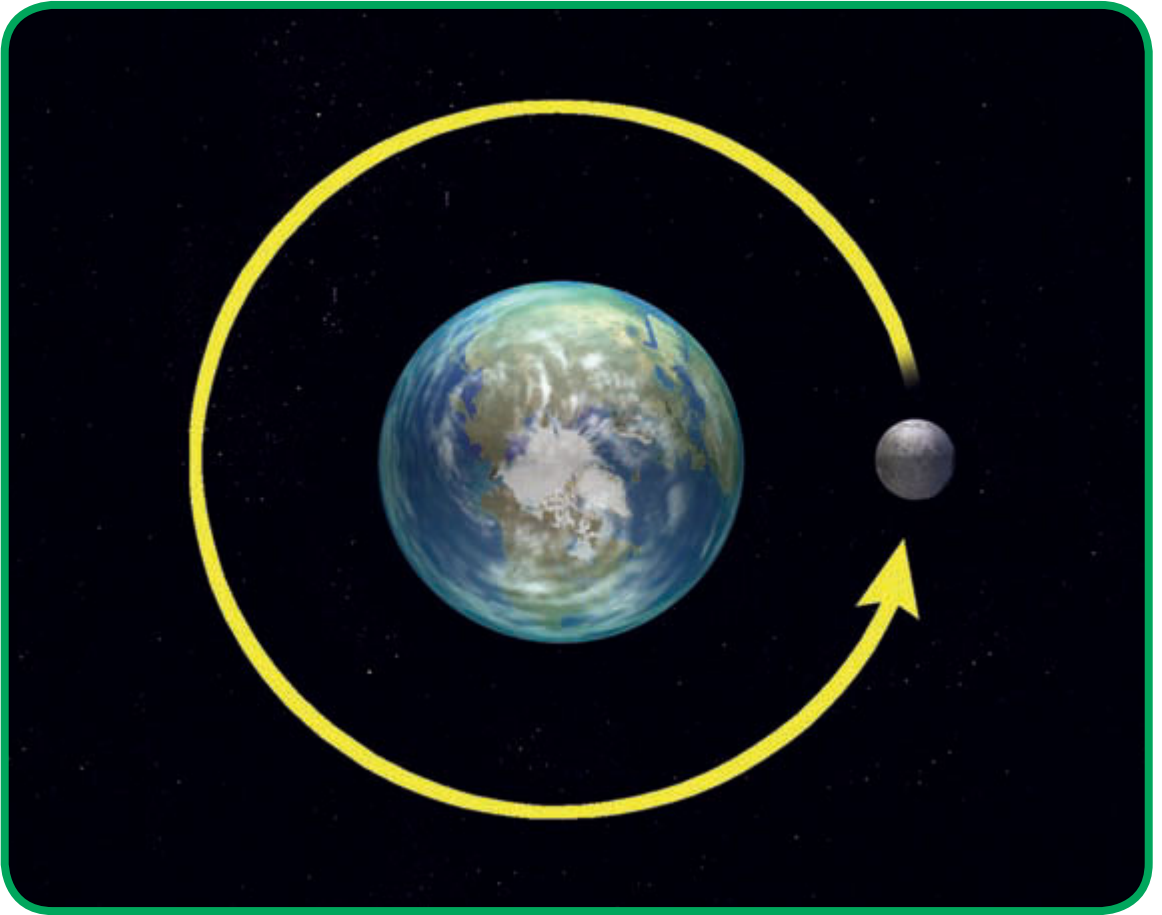
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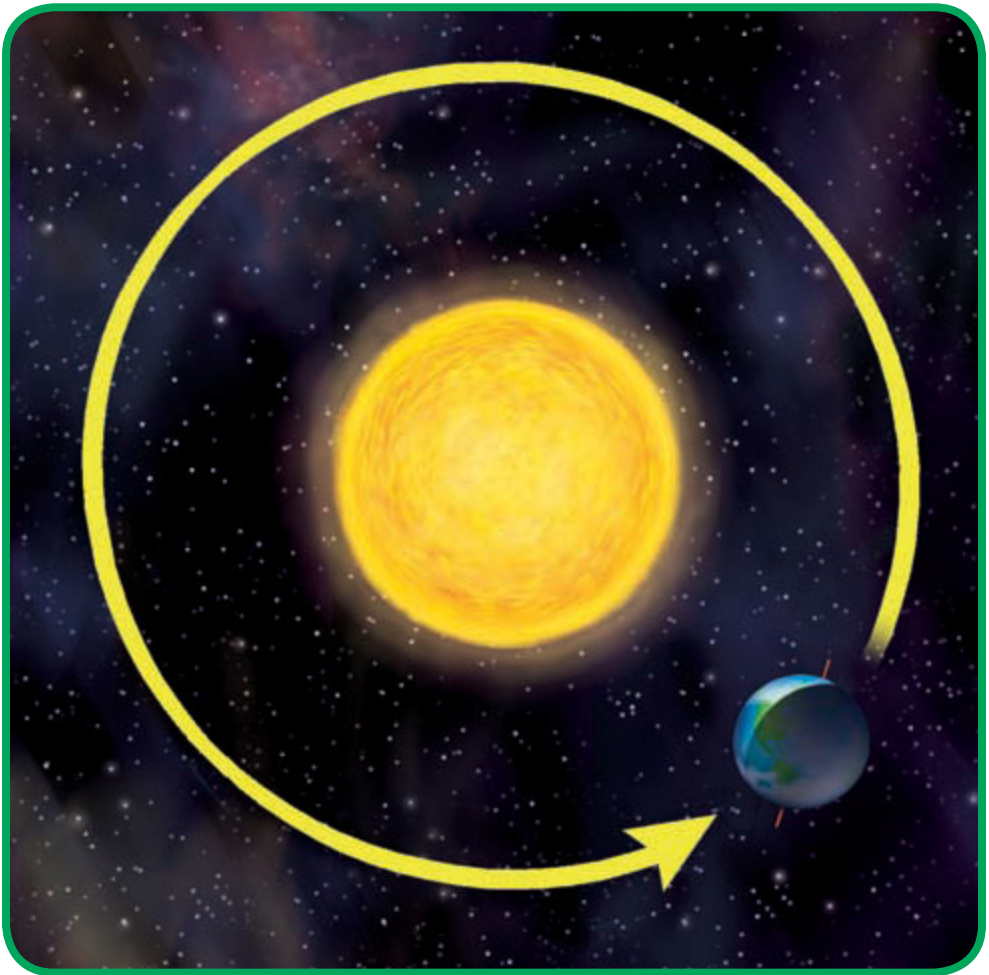
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Earth turns around in a circle.
It takes one day.



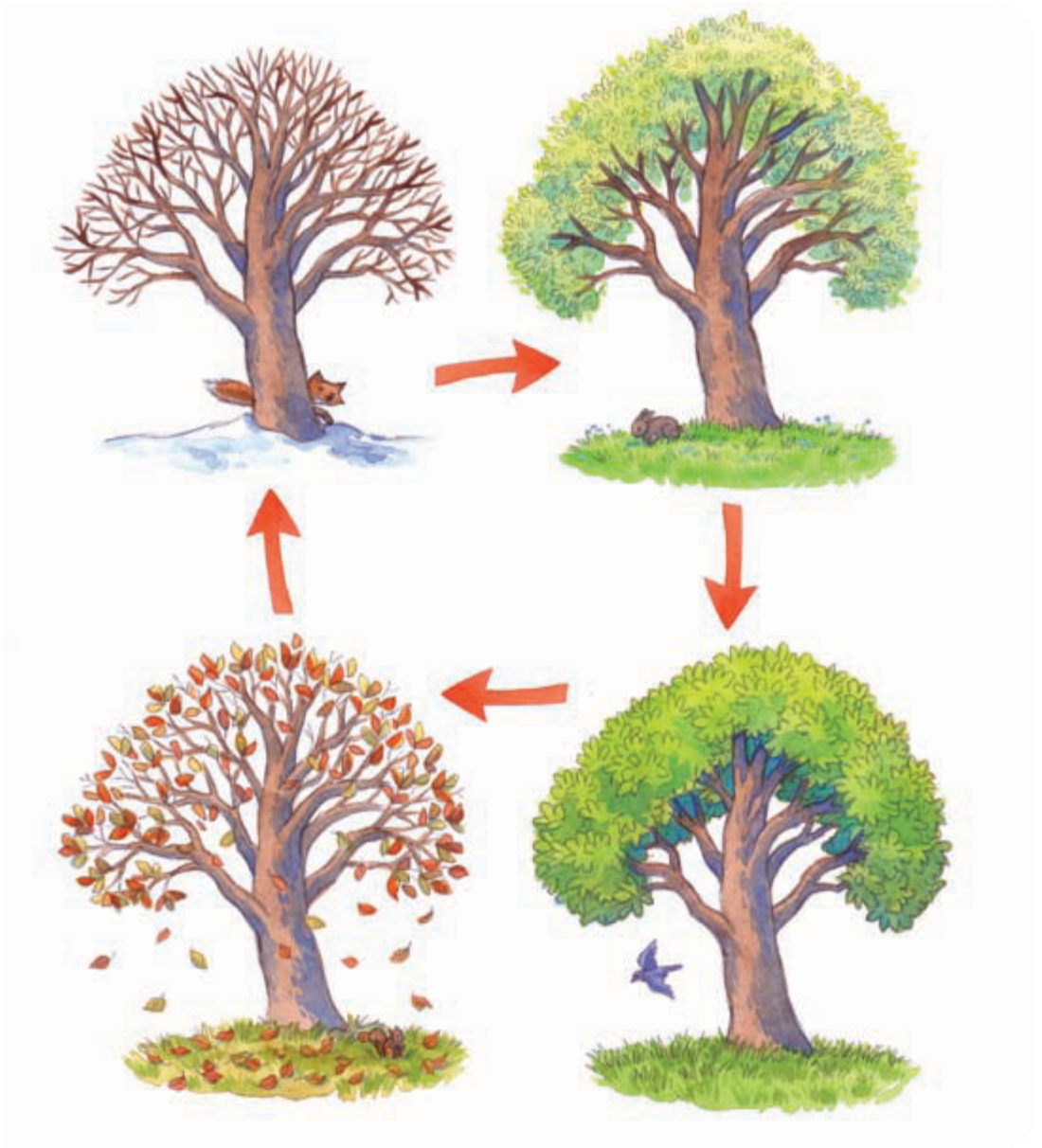
- 🔊 The moon moves around Earth.
