Understanding Concepts

- 1 The Constitutional Convention brought together 55 men from all over the country to represent their states. The youngest delegate was Jonathan Dayton (who was 26 in 1787); the oldest delegate was Benjamin Franklin, at 81. Most of the delegates were well-educated landowners who had worked in national or state politics in the 1770s and 1780s.
