Who is Israel's king? Yahweh is the true king of Israel.

This Versus That

Materials

A piece of paper, pen or pencil

Instructions

1. On the piece of paper, draw a line down the middle to form two columns. Label one column "king" and the second column "Yahweh."
2. Instruct the kids to describe a king to you. What does he wear? Does he need a crown? A throne? A scepter? While the kids are sharing their thoughts, write them in the "king" column.
3. Next, ask the kids to describe Yahweh to you. What are his characteristics? Is he strong? Trustworthy? While the kids are sharing their thoughts, write them in the "Yahweh" column.
4. Compare the two columns. Anything similar? What is different?

Point

Yahweh is Israel's true king. While a human king might wear a long robe or a shiny crown, Yahweh is the true king and does not need these items to prove it. Yahweh is the ultimate example that human kings should look to.
