

# Activity 6

What gift did God give the king to help him be obedient?

God gave the king a different heart and the anointing of his Spirit.

*Listen for the Ring, Part 2*

## Materials

Alarm clock\*, alarm clock batteries

## Instructions

1. Using the same alarm clock from Activity 5, pull out the batteries that should have been used for the alarm clock.
2. Ask: "Did I give the alarm clock what it needed to be obedient to make a sound after two minutes?" Say, "Well, if I put these batteries back into the alarm clock, do you think it would help it do what I intend it to do?"
3. Put the batteries back and set the timer for 2 minutes. When 2 minutes is up, the alarm should make a sound.
4. Explain that since you gave the alarm clock what it needed, it was able to do the task you needed it to.

## Point

It is difficult for the alarm clock to do what it is told, if it is not given the proper equipment and tools to do so. This is a lot like what God did for the king. God knew it would be difficult for the king to obey without giving him a different heart and the anointing of his Spirit. God gives us what we need!

\*You can substitute a phone alarm, and instead of inserting batteries, you would simply hit the start button. Adapt the activity questions as needed.
