Instructions

1. Tell the kids the first person to do 10 jumping jacks, touch each wall around the room, and give you a high five is going to win \$20.
2. After the first child wins, say: "I am glad I didn't *promise* to give you the \$20, because I don't have any cash! Would you like a handshake instead?"
3. Ask the kids if there is a difference between saying or not saying "I promise." Do they have any examples where a promise has been broken? How did it make them feel? Allow them to share.
4. Ask the kids why it is important to keep their promises. How do you make sure someone will keep what they said?

Point

A lot of the time, we can get disappointed because someone broke a promise to us. It's upsetting when someone breaks their word. But God doesn't break promises to us! God is faithful and true to His word. When God made a promise to David, David knew that he could trust God.
