## Who is Abraham?

Abraham is the father of the faithful ones of God.

### *Kids vs Parents*

#### **Materials**

Lots of paper

#### **Instructions**

1. Divide the group into two teams: "kids" and "parents." (both groups are made up of children, but one group is called "parents").
2. Explain that the job of the "kids" is to fill the room with tightly wadded paper wads and the job of the parents is to try to keep the room clean. They will have one minute of game time. If there are ten or more paper wads on the floor when time is up, the "kids" win. If there are less than ten, the "parents" win. If there are exactly ten, it is a tie. After you play once, you may need to adjust the number based on how good your kids are at making a mess.
3. Give the "kids" all of the paper, let them wad up the paper, and instruct them to wait for your signal to begin the game.
4. Play as many times as you can during your allotted time.

## **Point**

As the children of Abraham, we live inside the world of promise that God brought about through the father of the faithful, Abraham. Although it is much more significant than providing a clean room, Abraham's promise does provide us with a clean record. God sees all of those who trust in Christ as righteous and cleansed by his sacrifice.
