

# Activity 12

**What did Abraham learn in trusting God?  
Abraham learned that God keeps his  
promises and loves his people.**

*Primetime baseball*

## **Materials**

Cards with questions and answers from the creation cycle  
Whiteboard or poster board with a baseball diamond on it

## **Instructions**

1. Make cards with questions and answers from Creation and Abraham cycles on them.
2. Split the class into two groups, boys vs. girls. Let them know that all Q and A from Creation and Abraham cycle are fair game, and give them a minute or two to review the cards that will be used in the game.
3. This game works like baseball, sort of. Draw a baseball diamond on the whiteboard or poster board. If a kid gets a question correct, that is a base hit. If he/she gets it wrong, that is a strike.
4. If, however, the other team can get it right, that makes the strike an out instead. Three strikes is an out as well. Three outs per team, per inning. Play as long as it is fun. It is great review, great fun, and maybe it will encourage further memorization.

## **Point**

Obviously this is not an activity that drives home the week's lesson, but this game will come up as an activity every few weeks, so let the kids know that.
