Kids

Who are the children of God's promise to Abraham?

The children of Abraham are all those who trust God and hold onto his promises.

What are you doing?

Materials

None

Instructions

1. Have the kids stand in a circle. Once there, explain that they are going to have to use all their powers of concentration for this game.
2. A kid will be chosen to start. That kid will start acting out a simple activity that everyone knows.
3. The player on his/her right will ask the question "What are you doing?" Here's the catch, the person cannot answer with what he/she is actually doing, but has to think of another activity immediately. So if the kid is acting out talking on the telephone, then he/she has to answer with something else like, "brushing my teeth".
4. The person who asked the question then has to act like he/she is brushing their teeth. This continues around the circle. If there's a hesitation to answer, or if the answer is the same as what the kid is actually doing, that kid is out. Also, if the person who asks fails to act out that activity immediately, he/she is out.

Point

Just as we had to hold onto our memory of what the person next to us has said and done, the children of Abraham are called to remember what God has said and done. He has given us a promise and in Jesus he has prove that it's true. We hold onto his promise because it is what gives us hope for the future.
