What was the first promise God gave to Abraham?

God promised to bless Abraham with many children.

It's Promise Time

Materials

None

Instructions

1. Choose one kid to be "Bad Abraham" and have this child stand at one end of the room.
2. Explain that Bad Abraham's job is to collect as many children as possible. Since Bad Abraham does not believe God will be faithful, he has to take matters into his own hands.
3. Line the rest of the kids up on the wall opposite Bad Abraham, and tell them to shout out, "What time is it, Bad Abraham?" When Bad Abraham yells out a time, the kids will take that many baby steps forward. So if Bad Abraham says "it's 6 o'clock", all the kids will take 6 baby steps forward. However, if at any point Bad Abraham answers, "It's Promise Time", his job is now to chase and tag someone who will be the next Bad Abraham. If the kids manage to sneak close enough to tag Bad Abraham before he yells, "It's Promise Time", then the kids have won.
4. Play as many times as you can during your allotted time.

Point

Explain that we can trust God, and because of that we don't need to take God's promises into our own hands.
