What was the second promise God gave to Abraham?

God promised to bless Abraham and his children with a land of their own.

Going to the Land of the Promise

Materials

None

Instructions

1. Break the kids into groups of ten or fewer.
2. Have the kids draw numbers to line up in numerical order.
3. Start with the child in the very back and instruct him/her to challenge the person in front of him/her for position. Explain that the very front of the line is the "Land of Promise." Your goal is to be at the front.
4. For the challenge, the leader will read one question from the Kaleid Q and A and the two children will have an opportunity to answer it. The one in front will go first and the challenger will go second.
5. If the first child misses the answer, the challenger can steal the spot and move forward by getting the answer right. Whoever gets it right challenges the next person in line. If neither child answers correctly, the challenger loses, and the person challenged gets to challenge the next person in line.

6. Once the challenges have reached the front of the line, you can announce a winner or draw numbers and play again. Feel free to use Q and A from both Creation and Abraham.

Point

Explain that Abraham and his children faced many challenges, but God was always faithful to his promise.
