What did Abraham learn in trusting God? Abraham learned that God keeps his promises and loves his people.

Puzzle

Materials

Poster board Masking tape Markers Scissors

Steps

- Give each group a large poster board and PLENTY of markers/ crayons/colored pencils, etc.
- 2. Draw a cross in the middle and then allow the kids to make a collage by coloring and drawing around the cross.
- 3. Cut the poster board up into pieces.
- 4. Write on the back of each piece the general spot on the 'puzzle' where it would fit (for example: "just left of the center about halfway down). Then number them randomly 1-whatever number you have. So if there are twenty pieces, number them 1-20.
- 5. Next make a rectangle about the size of the puzzle out of masking tape on the floor. Kids will place their puzzle piece on the floor in the order they are numbered and will try and place their piece in the location indicated on the back. So kid

- number one will go first, and if his puzzle piece says "just left of center about halfway down" he will try and place his puzzle piece in that spot. The kids will progress in order.
- 6. There is a catch. The first time they do this exercise, the kids will be blindfolded and simply guided to the location of the rectangle. They are not allowed to feel for other pieces. They are only allowed to feel the perimeter of the rectangle and try to place their piece appropriately. After going through this exercise blindfolded, let them see the result. Then, allow them to do it without blindfolds.

The Point

Sometimes in life we are a part of something much more complicated and much more beautiful than we realize, because our sight is so limited and we can often only see ourselves.
