How did God help Abraham trust God's promises?

God changed Abraham's name to mean "father of nations".

Wooden Name Plaque

Materials

Access to online name dictionary

Post it notes

Pencils

Brown construction paper

Scissors

Black markers

Yarn

Tape

Steps

1. Let them know that the brown construction paper is going to be like a wooden plaque.
2. Have children cut along the edges of their construction paper to give them a look of wood. The edges could be zigzagged or curved.
3. During this time, adults can look up the meanings of their names to write on a post it for them. If possible, you might want to do this ahead of time.

4. Have children write their name in large letters with a black marker across the center of the brown paper.
5. Then, they will write the meaning of their name in black in a smaller print under their name.
6. Have them use the black marker to add detail like darkened wood around the edges.
7. Last, have them cut a piece of yarn and tape it to the back to serve as a wall hanger.

The Point

Because Abraham is the "father of nations," we can learn from him how to become God's child through faith. Just like our names have meaning for us, Abraham's name has meaning for all of us.
