## How did God prepare Moses for Leadership?

God protected Moses from disaster and spoke to him directly.

*You want me to do WHAT?!*

### **Materials**

- Various household objects
- Something to use as a blindfold

### **Instructions**

1. Moses was the “go-between” for God and Israel and was asked to lead them through some pretty crazy things. He wasn’t perfect, but God spoke to him, and Moses listened for each next instruction.
2. Create a simple obstacle course using things from your home (ie. a pillow to walk around, a table to go under, a stool to step over, a cup to pick up and carry somewhere new...) and blindfold your child at the beginning of the course.
3. Tell your child the goal is to safely get to the end, without bumping into things or knocking things over, but they must listen to you closely.
4. Give your child step by step instructions (bend down, take two steps forward, big step up, etc.)

5. When your children have completed the obstacle course, ask them how they knew where to go next? Were they nervous because they couldn't see? Who knew what was coming on the course? Did they trust you to give good instruction?

**Point**

God speaks to protect the people he loves. He asked Moses to lead the Israelites, and may ask us to do some hard things. God will give us the instructions we need for the exact moment we need them. God's people know His voice and trust Him to give good instructions, because He is the only one who knows everything.
