Why did God listen to Israel's cries for help?

Materials

-Walkie talkies (or just two phones)

Instructions

1. Give your child one walkie talkie and keep the other for yourself. Show them that you have put them on the same channel and let them know this walkie talkie will let them talk to you from anywhere in the house.
2. Spread out a bit in your house and use them to talk to each other. You can play a game of hide and seek or a round of 20 (or less) questions! You can even do a hot and cold game to try and find each other using only the walkie talkies to tie clues.
3. How did the walkie-talkies help you communicate? Did you have to scream through the house wondering if the other person could hear you? Was it important for them to be on the right channels?

Point

When Israel cried out they had been given a direct line to communicate God and he heard them. God is faithful to keep his promises so he was accountable to his word and rescued Israel from their misery to bring them into the promised land.
