How did God make His presence known to the family nation of Israel?

While Israel camped in tents God's presence dwelt in a tent as well, the Tabernacle.

## *Fire and Clouds*

### **Materials**

Red, yellow, orange construction paper  
Cotton balls  
Scissors  
Glue  
Black marker or crayon

### **Steps**

1. Cut a large heart from the red construction paper.
2. Cut flame shapes from the red, yellow, and orange construction paper to represent fire.
3. Glue the flames to the center of the heart.
4. Spread the cotton balls into long strips, and glue them to the edges of the heart making a cotton outline around the heart.
5. Use the black marker or crayon to write "God's Presence" in the center of the heart.

## **The Point**

Remind them that God's presence appeared to the Israelites as a cloud by day and fire by night, and

His presence dwelt in the Tabernacle. The cotton balls represent the clouds and the flames represent the fire. The heart



shape represents our hearts where God's presence lives if we are believers.
