How did God rescue the family of Israel from exile and slavery?

God sent ten plaques on Egypt and humbled them until they let His people go.

Rescue Rings

Materials

Construction paper

Scissors

Glue

Markers

Steps

1. Cut 20 one inch strips of construction paper.
2. Write a different plaque or draw an image to represent each plaque on ten of the strips. (blood, frogs, gnats, flies, livestock, boils, hail, locust, darkness, and death of first born)
3. Using one strip, glue the edges and make a circle.
4. Then, take another strip, loop it through the circle strip, and glue the edges to make a connected circle. Continue this until all ten strips are glued in connecting loops like a chain.
5. Use the rest of the strips to think of times that God has rescued you and add them to the chain.

The Point

Remind them that God rescued the Israelites from exile and slavery by sending the plagues. The connected strips of papers represent a chain, and it will serve as a reminder of the Israelites being slaves to the Egyptians. The added strips are to help us realize all of the ways that God continues to rescue us.
