Who is God?

God is the creator of me and all things.

Read:

Psalm 104:24-30

Pray:

Reflecting on Psalm 104, praise God that in His wisdom He created all things, and that just as his creation cannot be numbered, he cannot be measured. Praise God that not only did he create all things, but he provides all that is needed for His creation.

Do:

- Together, take a walk outside (or take a look out your window)
- Ask your children which plants and animals they see. Which ones can you name?
- Prompt them to look in unexpected places: What do you see in the sky? On the ground? Under this rock? In the water?
- Help them to make observations: What do they notice that is special? What does it feel/look/sound/smell like? If you're in a garden is there something you can taste?

Discuss:

Psalm 140 tells us that God made **all** things. In fact, God made so many things that we could never count them all. He is responsible for every detail in His creation and He provides the things His creatures need and causes them to live and grow

People will spend the rest of time trying to figure out how all the things God made work, and how they work together. But God is full of wisdom. He makes and sustains (keeps alive and working) everything we see, and more, without struggle.

Spend time praising God for who He is. Thank Him for His wisdom and creativity in making the world so big and beautiful.

Who is God?

Creation Scene

Materials

White construction paper
Blue, green, and brown paint
Paper plate

Steps

1. Pour small drops of paint onto the paper plate for a pallet of colors.
2. Talk about some things that God created on our earth.
3. Walk your child through making a creation scene by using only their fingerprints.
4. Have them start by making green grass.
5. Then, use the brown for a tree trunk and green for the leaves.
6. Last, they will use blue for the sky.
7. They can also create fingerprint animals.

The Point

Remind them that God made all things. He's the creator of you, the grass, the trees, the sky, the stars, and the animals.
