Breastfeeding is a natural process, but it is not always easy. During the first few weeks there is a lot to learn about how mother breasts functions, and how this baby feeds. No one set of rules exists to guide you. Each mother and child are different. That's why we are here to support you through this process.

After you and your baby are discharged from the hospital, you will be contacted by our Lactation Consultant, Lisa Boule'. She will assess the status of feeding with you, answer any questions you may have, and set up the first visit in our office. In addition to being a Lactation Consultant, Lisa is also a Certified Pediatric Nurse Practitioner. During the first visit, your baby will be weighed and examined by Lisa, then she will monitor a feeding to help assess and troubleshoot any issues you might be having. Lisa is also available via telephone 24/7 to answer any questions you may have throughout your breastfeeding experience.

The Lactation Room is located at 7 Old Sherman Turnpike, Suite 205 in Danbury (please see directions below). It is located in the practice's billing office suite. When you come for a visit, we ask that you come with the baby fairly hungry.

Lactation Consultations are billed out through your medical insurance as an office visit. Most insurance companies cover the cost of the visit. If you have questions concerning coverage, please contact your insurance company.

Directions from I-84 East Bound

Take exit 8 off of I-84 and get in the middle lane. At the end of the exit ramp, go straight (the road will curve to the left). Take your first right onto Old Sherman Turnpike. The office is located in the first building on the right (7 Old Sherman Turnpike, Suite 205).

Directions from I-84 West Bound

Take exit 8 off of I-84. At the end of the exit ramp, head into the far left lane as soon as possible (look for signs that say 84E and/or Rte. 6E). The far left lane will curve to the left and bring you to a traffic light. Go through the traffic light and take your first right onto Old Sherman Turnpike. The office is located in the first building on the right (7 Old Sherman Turnpike, Suite 205).
