

Created to Show God's Glory

Read Psalm 104: 1, 10-14, 24-25, 31-32 then briefly consider the questions below.

This week in Children's Worship, the kids are learning that all of creation, and humankind, was made to tell of the greatness of God! As we prepare our hearts to teach this essential truth, let's reflect on what Scripture says about how creation reflects God's greatness.

When we read Psalm 104:1, the psalmist describes God as one who is "clothed with splendor and majesty."

- What images come to your mind when you hear the words "splendor" and "majesty"?
- What aspects of creation reveal these attributes?

All throughout Psalm 104 the Psalmist speaks of God's work and character revealed in creation.

- What attributes of God do you see in creation? (Ex: God's provision in giving all animals something to eat; God's creativity in creating ocean life; etc.)

Our lesson will teach the kids that God did not *only* create a vastly unique world, but He filled it with unique people in order to show His glory.

- How have you learned more about God by being in relationship with others?
- How can you choose to be a better reflection of God's character today?
