Read Isaiah 46:9b, Jeremiah 10:6, 2 Samuel 7:22 in your Bible, then briefly consider the questions below.

This week in Children's Worship, the kids are learning that God is unique and greater than anything, or anyone, else. Scripture teaches us that God is...

All-powerful

All-knowing

Omnipresent

God never changes

God is perfect in love, patience, kindness, etc.

Please take a minute and describe how God has shown you some of these characteristics within the past week.

We serve a God who is far greater than our wildest imagination. Sometimes it is difficult for us to logically understand God's nature, and need to rely on faith.

- Which characteristics of God's nature are hardest for you to grasp?

Take a look at Acts 17:24-25.

We serve a God who does not need anything or anyone, yet he chooses to use ordinary people like you and me to do his kingdom work. How amazing is that?! This week, the God who made the world and everything in it is using YOU to influence the children of CGS.

- How does it make you feel knowing that God does not **need** you to accomplish his will, but he **wants** to use you? How can that empower you to keep doing his kingdom work?

Lastly, John Piper gives a great 10-minute description of Psalm 50:8-15. In it, he reminds us of our role in serving the God who needs nothing. Feel free to check it out!
