

Worthy Is the Lamb

Read Revelation 5:1-14, then briefly consider the questions below.

This week in Sunday School, the kids will learn that Jesus is the Lamb who is worthy, and one day all of creation will worship Him. Although we yearn for the day when we all will praise Jesus together in the New Creation, we can glorify God with our lives now. As believers, we worship God with our dreams, vocations, relationships, and hobbies.

As the four living creatures sing their song of praise in Rev. 5:9-10, we are reminded once again of the beauty of the Gospel.

- According to verse 9, *who* has been purchased? How does this affect the image and sound of those praising the Lamb?
- What are the two purposes for those purchased for God (vs. 10)?

Take a moment to reread Rev. 5:11-12 and imagine hearing the words of praise that were being given to the Lamb.

- Consider your own actions, words, thoughts, etc. from this past week. Was God glorified through you? How did you give praise to God this week?
