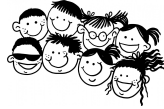


See What God Makes

God makes people.

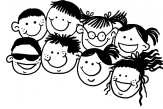

- Verse for parents:
Ephesians 2:10 -"For we are his workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand, that we should walk in them."

Ideas for how to encourage the lesson during the week:

- Pull out some playdough and practice making "people" together. Help littles roll the dough into balls and let them have fun feeling the squishy dough!
- For older littles: Make a self portrait. Provide paper, crayons, and a mirror. Ask your little one to look in the mirror and help them draw what they see. After they draw their portrait, ask them, "Did God make you special? What is your favorite thing you see?"
- For younger littles: Look in a mirror and point to their nose, eyes, ears, and mouth saying "God made your nose, God made your eyes, etc."
