ASSISTANCE TO FAMILY RESETTLING IN DURHAM

Together with World Relief, CGS is collecting items for a refugee family as they settle in Durham after having moved here from the Congo. We will continue receiving items on the list **through May 30** since housing has not been found yet. Some of the items we still hope to collect include bowls and plates for four people, six-gallon and 13-gallon trash cans, a floor lamp, twin blankets, and kitchen knives. You may leave your items in the collection bins at the entrances of CGS except for large furniture items, mattresses and bed frames which will be collected from people's homes (not from CGS). We are also trying to line up volunteers to transport the items that have been donated once housing has been found for the family. This will be done in the cars belonging to volunteers and in larger vehicles that folks are letting us borrow.
