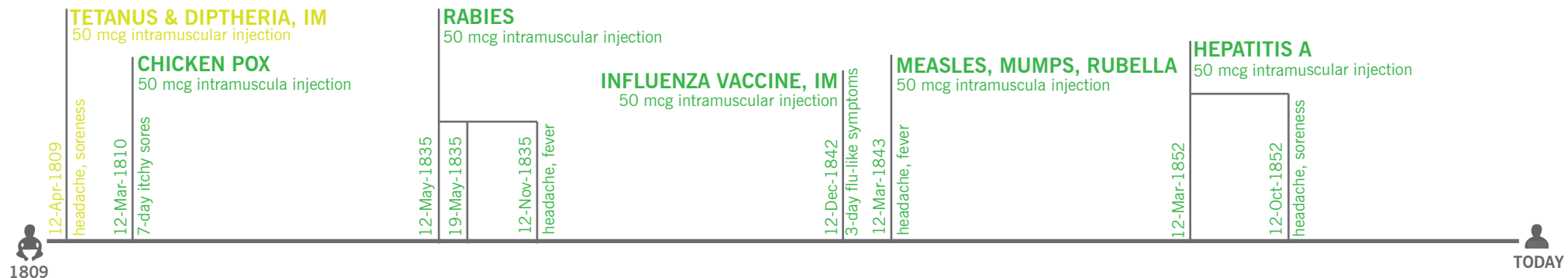

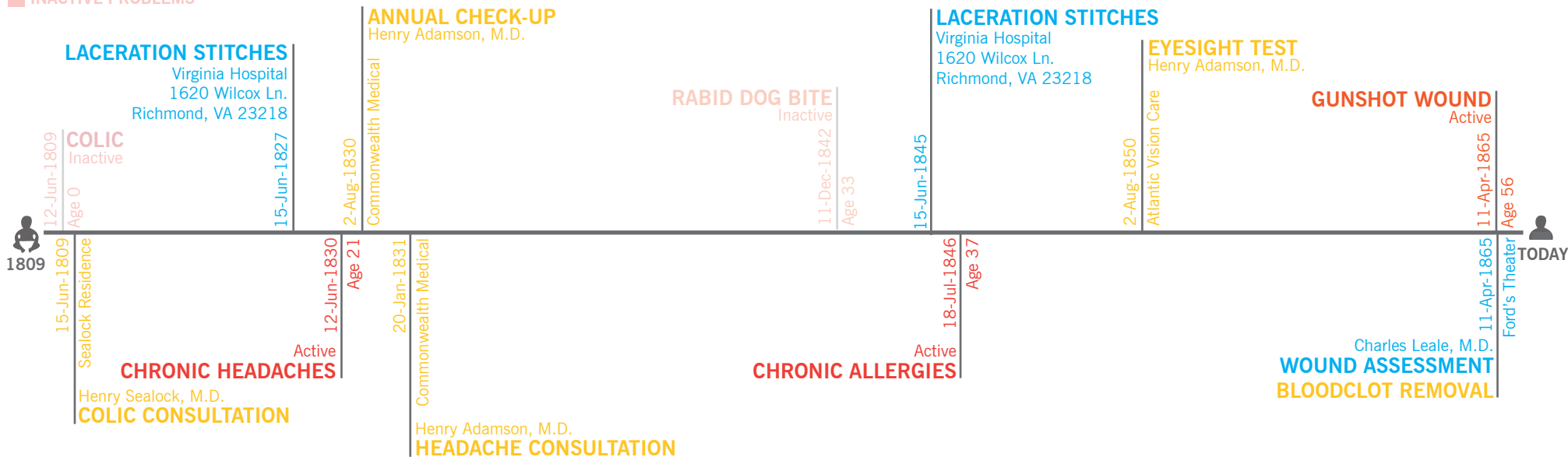

TEST	RESULT	EXPLANATION	DISCUSS WITH YOUR DOCTOR?
CHOLESTEROL	HIGH	May indicate a high risk of heart disease, depending on risk factors	YES
VITAMIN D	MED	May cause loss in calcium causing weak bones and teeth, OTC supplements recommended	NO
CRP	HIGH	High level are linked to blood vessel inflammation and may indicate increased risk of heart disease	YES
PSA	MED	25% chance of prostate cancer for men ages 50-59	NO
GLUCOSE (FASTING)	IDEAL	Ideal glucose levels may indicate you are not at risk for prediabetes	NO
