SUBJECT: OIL FILTER CHANGE FOR 1968 PRODUCTION

Starting with the 1968 Production Engines, we will no longer have two types of oil filters; namely: the "replaceable element" type as used on the V-8 Engines and the "throw-away" type as used on the 6-Cyl. Engines.

Both of the present filters are being cancelled and replaced by a common "throw-away" type filter. surplus stock of the present V-8 type filters (#701222) may be used for Service and are not interchangeable with the new filter. All surplus stock of the present 6-Cyl. type filters (#701069) may be used without obsolescence and are completely interchangeable with the new 1968 filters; on 6 Cyl. Engines only.
