SUBJECT: FEDERAL MOTOR VEHICLE SAFETY STANDARD CERTIFICATION LABEL REVISION

Effective Jan. 1, 1969, the present 704338 FMVSS Certification Label attached to the LH Front Door Hinge Pillar will be cancelled and replaced by 644627 Aluminum Plate, pop riveted to the pillar.

The following information must be stamped into the plate before attachment to the vehicle:

- Month and Year Built - (For example: Jan. 1969)
- Vehicle Ident. Number - (For example: A-11 3506-90051)
- Type of Vehicle - Passenger (Use for all vehicles except Rail Car and A-12W8)
 - Multipurpose Pass. (Use for Rail Car only)
 - Bus (Use for A-12W8 only)

Also required will be a revision to Production Order Window Label incorporating the above information along with a statement that "this vehicle meets all applicable Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standards in effect on date of manufacture".
