SUBJECT: PAINTING OF CHEVROLET KIT PARTS

Effective with this memorandum, all parts received in the various purchased Chevrolet Kits should be inspected to determine if painting is required before sending to production. A check with Chevrolet End Products has revealed that the parts will not necessarily be painted.

If it is found that any of the metal items are not painted or plated, arrangements should be made for these parts to be painted. In order for the labor cost of painting to be obtained, an "x" will be shown in the "make" column of the Bill of Material and the release will also indicate to paint if required.

Please notify the writer of any unpainted parts and records will then be adjusted. To date, the Carburetor Air Heat Stove items are the only parts to be painted.
