SUBJECT: LOCATIONS FOR VEHICLE CHASSIS NUMBERS

This memo supersedes Engineering Memo #357.

In order to continue conformance with automotive industry practices and compliance with laws now in effect, the chassis number in 1/4 inch characters for each vehicle will be stamped on the engine and transmission bosses.

The size of the numbers currently being stamped on the frame will remain the same, but will not require the model designation prefix.

EXAMPLE:

For a vehicle in which the V.I.N. is A12-3426-00008D; the frame, engine boss and transmission boss would be stamped 00008D.

Location of the bosses are as follows:

Transmission - In a vertical plane and located approximately 3 inches in front of the T.C.S. terminal on left side of transmission.

V/6 and V/8 Gasoline Engine - On cylinder block top surface, right bank front, near upper right hand mounting bolt of water pump.

V/8 Diesel Engine - On boss under front of left cylinder head.

This change to be effective at once.
